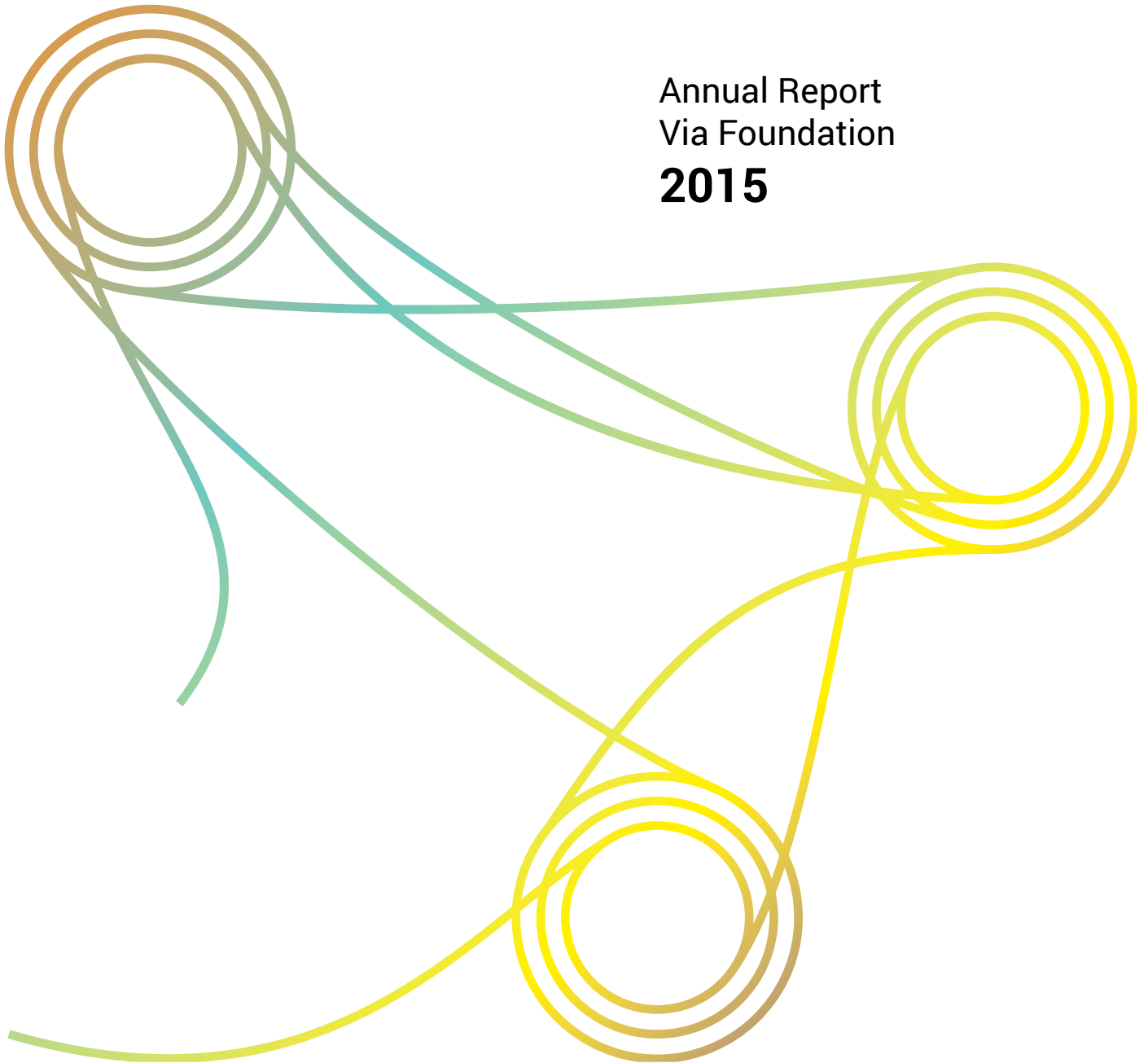

FOREWORD



Dear Friends,

In 2015, the Via Foundation celebrated its 18th birthday. It was the year in which the foundation symbolically reached adulthood and it was also a year of significant changes for us.

Via Foundation has a new identity and a new logo with three dots that signify Via's three core values: freedom, meaningfulness and responsibility.

There's much more to our new identity than just a new logo. Czech society is more mature than it was 18 years ago and as a result some aspects of our work are changing. In 1997, there were few people or non-profit organizations actively working in communities in the Czech Republic, but the situation has changed for the better since then. Today, there are thousands of non-profit organizations in the Czech Republic as well as many other people who associate in groups that are not formally classified as non-profit organizations. These people spontaneously join together to take the initiative to improve their communities.

In response, we do more than provide grants at Via Foundation: we also facilitate connections among people, share new knowledge with them, provide opportunities for mutual inspiration, and guide them. Our work is focused on two main areas of development – what we call “the art of giving” and “the art of co-existing together” – or in other words, philanthropy and community development.

Community development includes projects led by groups of people that step out beyond their personal lives into the public sphere and choose to work collaboratively to improve and care for their communities. These groups work on diverse projects – such as restoring a park, revitalizing a small monument

or holding a neighborhood gathering. As a result, they develop new relationships, learn to work together, care for their shared environment and experience something positive together.

Philanthropy development at Via Foundation is comprised of programs through which we develop charitable giving in the Czech Republic. These programs lead young people towards generosity and engagement in their communities, develop on-line giving and strive to inspire Czechs by sharing news about Czech philanthropists.

“The art of giving” and “the art of co-existing together” – does it sound too lofty to you? Well, perhaps it is. However, Via Foundation truly believes that people who work collaboratively to improve their communities and give to others make the Czech Republic a better place to live. We believe that groups of active, interconnected people across the entire Czech Republic are the cornerstones of a mature society that is more resilient to pressure, tremors and even, if we take it to the extreme, attempts to install a totalitarian regime, which may come at any time.

In sum, Via Foundation believes that “the art of giving” and “the art of co-existing together” are the foundations of a free society, a better future for the Czech Republic and something that you may not find in a dictionary but that could be simply called “a good life”.

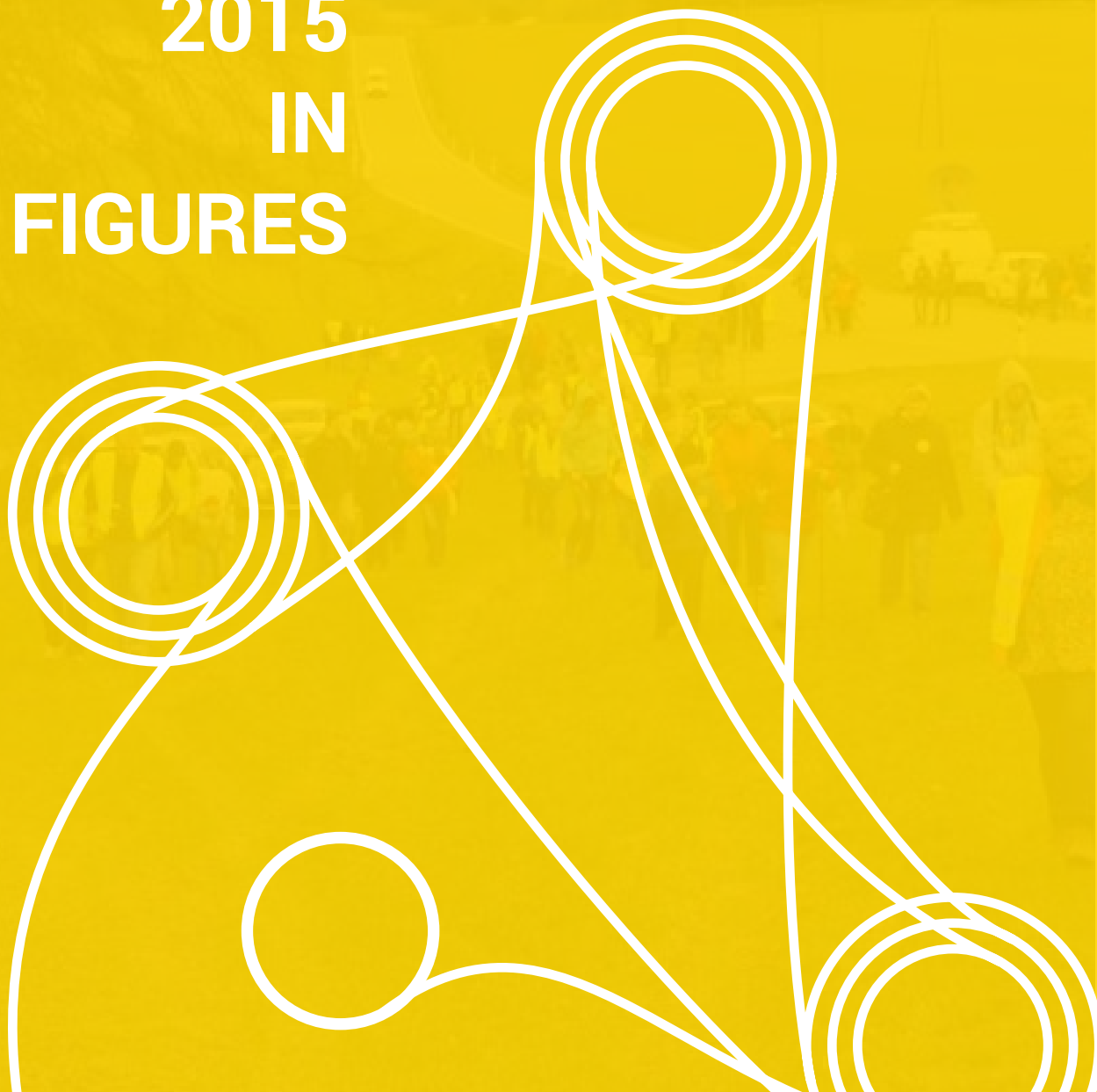


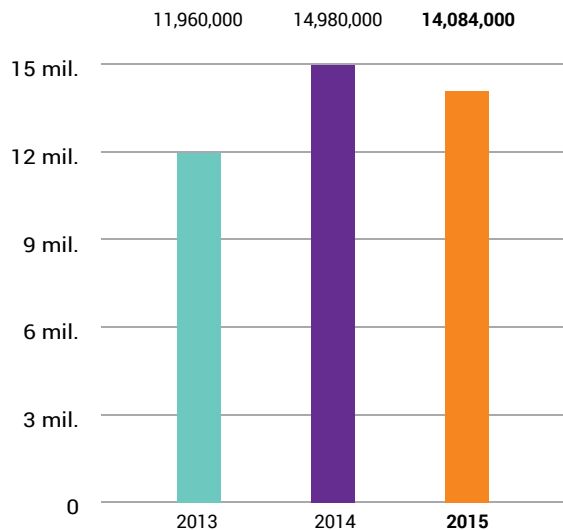

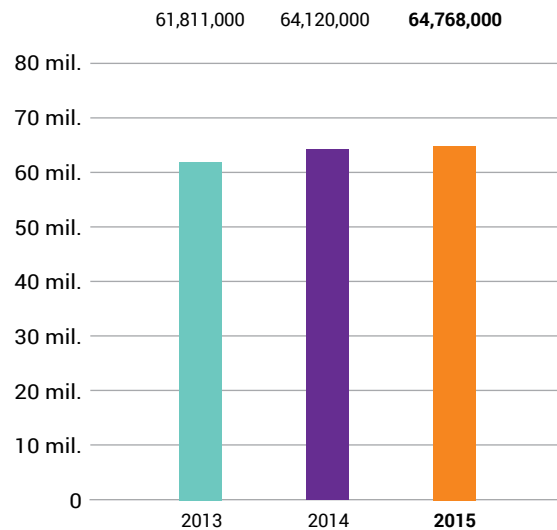


In 2015 disbursed a total of **CZK 14,084,092** in grants.

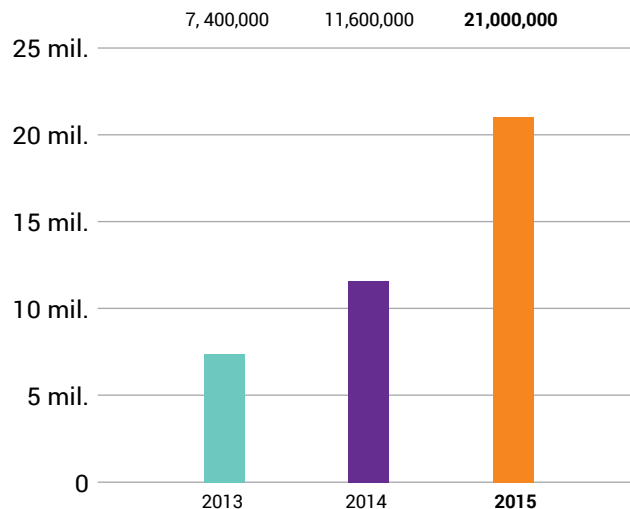

WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO



OUR MISSION:

Spread the art of giving and the art of co-existing together in the Czech Republic.

OUR VISION:

Our vision is a society in which people act freely and courageously, accept responsibility for themselves and their community, and where giving is a regular part of life.

We believe that we can fulfill this vision by focusing on community and philanthropy development.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND THE ART OF CO-EXISTING TOGETHER

We seek out, connect and support individuals and groups of people changing their communities for the better. We support people who take the initiative themselves rather than waiting for others to intervene; people who work together to make Czech cities and towns come alive again. Specifically, people who transform and revitalize public spaces, restore neglected small monuments or organize neighborhood gatherings – shaping community life and doing whatever is needed in their communities to bring people together.

PHILANTHROPY DEVELOPMENT AND THE ART OF GIVING

Via seeks to make giving a normal and regular part of life in the Czech Republic by supporting the idea that giving isn't only for the wealthy; anyone can be a philanthropist. You can give others your time, energy, knowledge or money. Our philanthropy development work focuses on young philanthropists,

on recognizing inspirational stories of giving, and on publishing the quarterly journal Art of Giving. We share inspiring stories from the USA and western Europe, where philanthropy and self-help are more established than in the Czech Republic.

OUR HISTORY

We are a private independent Czech foundation, which was established in 1997 to carry on the work of the Czech office of the American Foundation for a Civil Society. Since then we have supported almost 4,000 projects. Since 2005 two partner organizations - Friends of Via in Pittsburgh and Via civic association in Prague - have complemented the work of Via Foundation.



OUR PROGRAMS

Via Foundation fulfills its vision through programming which supports community development, philanthropy, education and development of community leaders in the Czech Republic. This section provides an overview of our programs and examples of supported projects.



THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH WE LIVE

Strmilov is a small town in South Bohemia where local residents rallied together to transform a long-overgrown site on the edge of town.

At the first community planning meeting in Strmilov, it quickly became clear that finding a compromise would be no easy task. Each group in the community – athletes, senior citizens, youth – had a different idea of how the park should serve the community. However, through the planning process and community work days, the groups and their ideas came together. In the end, Strmilov residents created a walking path, exercise equipment for senior citizens and youth, a BMX bike park and a seating area around a campfire circle.

Our support of the Strmilov project concluded in 2015, and we went on to select five new projects in The Community in Which We Live program that aim to revitalize public spaces in 2016.

How we supported them:

Each organization received a grant of CZK 300,000 – and guidance throughout the community planning process, construction phase and grand opening of the park. The program also included workshops and networking with other program participants.

About the program:

We select five organizations or municipalities to participate in the **The Community in Which We Live** program and we support them with a grant, workshops and ongoing consultations. We guide them throughout the entire process so that people in each community are able to revitalize the given public space according to their needs. We also guide them in learning to work together and developing new

A DIFFERENT TAKE ON PLACE – LIVE GRANTS

When walking with her baby stroller, Jitka Jakubičková of Vratislavice nad Nisou sometimes opted for an abandoned industrial zone rather than the local park. About a year ago, during one of those walks, she got the idea of revitalizing a unique landmark on the site – a water tower called Zauhlovačka. Her idea was to make it into a cultural center.

Since then, Jitka and the AvantgArt non-profit association and volunteers have spent countless hours cleaning dust and trash out of the tower. They are now working to develop it into a community center that will connect people from Vratislavice and nearby communities.

How we supported this project:

We awarded a grant of CZK 70,000 to the project Cultural center in a tower: Zauhlovačka. Project leaders also participated in Via workshops on “Mapping Community Needs” and “How to Share Your Story with Others”.

About the program:

Through Live Grants, we support revitalization of public spaces in the Czech Republic. Selected projects are based on volunteer work by people of different generations and professions – in short, everyone who is connected by the community in which they live.

A DIFFERENT TAKE ON PLACE – LIVE GRANTS

Residents in a small town on the border of the South Moravian and Vysočina regions protested against a proposal to build a nuclear waste storage site in their vicinity. They joined together in an association called “We Don’t Want the Kraví hora Nuclear Waste Storage Facility” and managed to get the proposal suspended. According to the project leaders, the facility would result in environmental damage to the region, which is already weighed down by a uranium mine and heavy industry.

The association held a demonstration, commissioned a nuclear waste storage specialist to elaborate an analysis and considered filing a lawsuit after the national government approved the project.

How we supported the project:

We supported the project with a grant of CZK 20,000 for the nuclear waste storage analysis and outreach programming.

About the program:

The Fast Grants program supports community groups addressing urgent local public interest issues. Common Fast Grant issues include inefficiency in local government, wasting of public resources, construction of unsuitable buildings and air and noise pollution. We also connect Fast Grants project leaders through our Citizen Activists Club, where they can exchange experiences and glean inspiration from one another. Fast Grants support also includes tailor-made consultations for citizen activists developing public information campaigns.

CULTURAL HERITAGE FUND

The municipality of Horní Vísky in the Tachov region died out after German residents were deported following World War II. In recent years, people from the nearby town of Lestkov have made efforts to remember the area's history. A series of crosses stands on the site where Horní Vísky once existed in commemoration of the last residents of the extinct municipality. Children from a local summer camp help care for the site and learn about its history.

How we supported this project:

With a Via Foundation grant of CZK 45,000, Lestkov residents restored five crosses and the surrounding area with the help of children from a summer camp. The children also spoke with local senior citizens about their memories of the extinct municipality and recorded a series of interviews.

About the program:

The program objective is to help people strengthen ties to their community and to each other through collaborative restoration of small monuments. Aside from facilitating restoration of the monument itself, we seek to help residents discover the history of their communities, build new relationships and strengthen existing friendships.

The Cultural Heritage Program did not accept new project proposals in 2015; 21 projects supported in late 2014 were completed over the course of the year.

POŠTOVNÍ SPOŘITELNA REGIONAL SUPPORT FUND - NEIGHBORS

How do you turn an anonymous housing estate into an active community? It's not easy, but Via Foundation has supported several projects led by people trying to do just that. One example is a community theater in the Černý Most housing estate on the outskirts of Prague.

The Černý Most housing estate includes a large number of disabled-accessible apartments and thus an unusually high number of disabled residents. It is sometimes difficult for the disabled population to interact with other residents in the housing estate. In response, a non-profit organization called The Theater of the Oppressed has organized a program for this housing estate that connects people of different generations, including disabled individuals. Together they engage in theater - but their talent or acting abilities are not the most important elements of the project. Rather, the focus is on creating opportunities for participants to meet new people and use theater as a tool for reflection on life in a housing estate.

How we supported the project:

We supported this project with a grant of CZK 100,000. The funds were used to design and print posters, develop a website, rent a theater workshop space, pay lecturer and director fees and buy material for costumes and stage sets.

About the program:

The program supports neighborly relations in towns, districts or streets. We believe that residents who get to know each other will be more likely to work together to make their communities better places to live. Thus,

T-MOBILE FUND

The Cejl district in Brno is a marginalized area but the group behind the Bronx Bus Stop project is trying to change it for the better. In the first part of the project, a local artists' group created a map of Cejl and involved a number of institutions, active citizens and students in the effort. Then they displayed the map at Cejl's most well known community event - the Ghettofest. During the event, residents wrote their feelings about specific sites on the map.

The second part of the project, which is currently underway, is about creating an unconventional guide book to Cejl. Local residents are helping with this effort, which aims to connect local residents and strengthen ties to their community.

How we supported this project:

With a grant of CZK 300,000.

About the program:

The program's key themes are communication, cooperation and integration. Aside from receiving funding, supported organizations can participate in free training from the T-Mobile Fund Academy, which offers consultations with experts from T-Mobile, practical one-day seminars and webinars and the opportunity to engage T-Mobile employee volunteers in projects.

BETTER BUSINESS: SUPPORT OF SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC

Is it possible to do business while also improving the world? Through the Better Business program, we support emerging firms that hope to do just that. The Pasparta Publishing House is one example, where profits and charity are so intertwined that charity actually helps the business succeed.

Pasparta Publishing is a social enterprise that employs people diagnosed with mild forms of autism (i.e., Asperger syndrome) and uses their specific talents, including graphic design skills. Pasparta publishes books about autism to raise public awareness of this disorder.

How we supported this project:

We supported this project with a grant of CZK 150,000, which was used primarily for book printing. The program also includes a series of workshops about e.g. finance and marketing and tailor-made consultations with coaches, mentors and business experts.

About the program:

The Better Business program supports business people who seek to make positive changes in society. Our goal is to support social enterprises with social, environmental, community and economic benefits.

LEADERSHIP AID

“Some childhood traits are retained through to adulthood – the courage to present something, defend your opinion, or stand up for others. Then there are other traits we grow into, sometimes over our whole lives or at least over many years. And I’ve got a lot of growing yet to do,” says Martina Kábelová, director of the Pelhřimov Regional Charity.

Martina grew into her current position gradually, step by step. She began as a volunteer and within ten years she had taken on a leadership role in the organization. Martina Kábelová is a participant in LeadershipAid, a program that guides leaders in the non-profit sector. The program is designed to help individuals find their own ways of growing into mature leaders.

How we supported Martina:

We supported Martina through coaching and a series of meetings and opportunities to share experiences with other NGO leaders and active citizens from across the Czech Republic.

About the program:

Leadership Aid supports and guides leaders of non-profit organizations and alternative movements, offering opportunities for skill development, personal experience, assistance, practice, sharing and personal growth.

VIADUKT

The ProMejto Association strives to show residents the architectural treasures of their town, Vysoké Mýto. It also tries to encourage residents to engage in local public space planning efforts. One of the members of the association took part in the Viadukt program.

One of the association's projects was to save an old brick factory from demolition. Despite ProMejto's protests, the building is no longer standing. This story is proof that not every effort ends in obvious success. Sometimes a more important outcome is what has been learned in the planning process. So when a project gives rise to new energy and relationships and increases people's drive to change things for the better, it can be considered a success.

How we supported the project:

We gave a series of "how to" seminars covering topics such as creating a vision and mission statement, raising funds for NGO projects, engaging the public and working with the media.

About the program:

Viadukt focuses on training people from NGOs and other active citizens trying to improve their communities. The program is based on several pillars: Guide, Collection and Advisor. Guide targets fledgling NGOs, while Collection offers workshops on community development topics and Advisor provides IT training.

VIABILITYNET 2.0

Laura Panait lives in the city of Cluj in Romania, where she is trying to make housing estates better places to live. Educated as an anthropologist, Laura is trying to engage people into public space revitalization in the Manastur housing estate, the biggest in the city, and make the space a community gathering spot.

Laura Panait was a participant of our international ViabilityNet 2.0 program. Although most of our work focuses on the Czech Republic, we also want to be connected with the broader world and connect community leaders from the region with similar experiences and goals.

How we supported Laura:

We supported Laura with funding, a series of training workshops and multiple-day workshops with other community leaders with similar goals from various Central and Eastern European countries.

About the program:

The program supports, educates and connects community leaders from Central and Eastern European countries. We support outstanding community leaders striving to initiate specific changes in their communities.

DARUJME.CZ

In 2015 people donated CZK 21 million to over 200 NGOs through Darujme.cz, our on-line giving tool. One recipient was the NGO A Dog's Life (Psí život). The organization is the only NGO in the Czech Republic helping animals belonging to homeless people, drug addicts and people living in socially marginalized areas.

How exactly does Darujme.cz help these organizations? "On-line fundraising is an important way of asking our donors, supporters and fans for help and receiving their valuable gifts: easily, quickly and securely. Even though our assistance is targeted to specific parts of the Czech Republic and Slovakia, we mainly fundraise on-line. With Darujme.cz, during our first year of what was literally a "living room" operation our NGO was able to raise more than CZK 700,000 from specific individual donors, with whom we are still in active contact," says Jarmila Pávková, chair of the association.

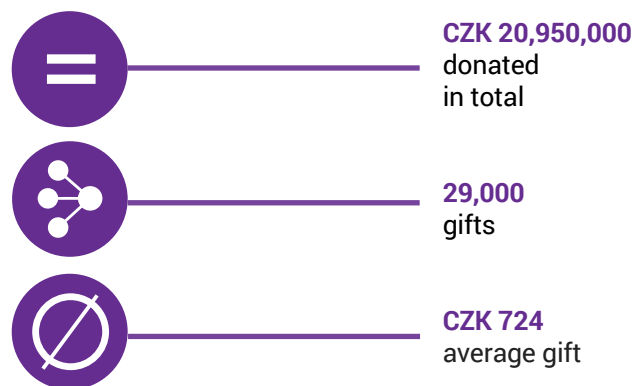
About the program:

Darujme.cz is an on-line fundraising tool for non-profit organizations. It enables them to reach out to new and current donors and easily ask them for a gift in the on-line environment, whether through a donor "widget" on the website or through an email campaign or different web application. Darujme.cz focuses on non-anonymous individual gifts.

BE HELPFUL

Twenty children between the ages of 7 and 10 from a drama club in Komořany in the Vyškov region put on a performance of Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs to raise money for their friend Kristýnka, who suffers from childhood polio.

The children reached out to sponsors and patrons for their benefit event themselves – celebrities such as the comedian Bolek Polívek and opera singer Magda Honzáková. They raised enough money to buy a special positioning chair for Kristýnka.

How we supported the group:

We gave the group a grant and training in benefit event organization. The children raised a total of CZK 47,120 and Via Foundation matched the sum with another CZK 39,000 with financial support from ČSOB.

About the program:

The program goal is to support groups of courageous and creative children and young people raising money for good causes. We provide them

with grants and training in our effort to lead children and youth towards philanthropy and community stewardship.

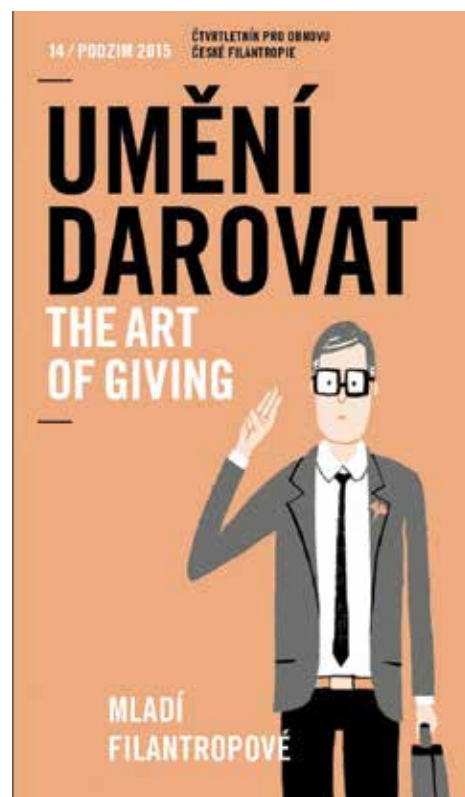

VIA BONA PHILANTHROPY AWARDS

Eighteen years ago her grandson was diagnosed with leukemia. He was cured but a 3 year old boy occupying the adjacent hospital bed died. According to his doctors, if he could have received a bone marrow transplant he would have survived. It was a turning point for Zdenka Wasserbauerová. Over the ensuing 18 years she has visited schools, lectured, persuaded laborers in factories – all to sign people up on the bone marrow donor registry. According to the Czech National Donor Registry, she has brought almost 9,000 people on board.

Zdenka Wasserbauerová was one of the winners of the 2015 Via Bona Philanthropy Awards, which we present each year to Czech philanthropists who give their time, energy or money in order to show that each and every one of us can become a philanthropist.

In 2015 we presented the Via Bona Awards in the following categories:

Personal Engagement Award

Zdenka Wasserbauerová for her exceptional endurance and altruism in recruiting new bone marrow donors in the Zlín region and for raising awareness among young adults about the importance of bone marrow donors.

Young Philanthropist Award

High school student Kateřina Vaňáková for implementing many charitable projects in her community. In 2014, she put on TOUR for Oxygen, a musical tour in Czech cities to raise money for an oxygen concentrator for Rozálka, a young girl with a genetic disease that gives her frequent respiratory problems.

Forging a New Path Award

Vojtěch Sedláček for his innovative support of homeless people. A business man in social services, he was the main initiator and patron of the project Start with a Roof (Nejdřív Střecha) in cooperation with the non-profit organization Naděj (Hope). This project affords homeless people free housing for up to two months.

Award for a Bequest

Professor Kateřina Šmídková for her bequest to the Czech Economic Society (Česká společnost ekonomická). The gift was allocated for the creation of a prize to support Czech female economists, who struggle for equal status in this field.

Individual Donor Award

Libor Winkler for his systematic support of the anti-corruption project Reconstruction of the State (Rekonstrukce státu). This joint effort of non-profit organizations and other partners aims to get nine anti-corruption laws passed.

Small and Medium-Sized Company Award

Konzum Cooperative in Ústí nad Orlicí for its longstanding support of many social projects in the Orlický, Rychnov and Svitavy regions.

Large Corporation Award

NET4GAS, s.r.o., for longstanding, generous support of the Czech Union of Nature Preservationists (Český svaz ochránců přírody). Since 2007, the NET4GAS corporate program titled Closer to Regions has enabled the Union to make 70 natural areas publicly accessible.

Public's Choice Award (public online voting at www.umimetouzoddetstvi.cz)

First, third, fourth and 4C classes, Gymnázium Jateční, Ústí nad Labem, for a series of unique charitable projects. Students of the Gymnázium Jateční have been involved in charity work for many years: some students tutor kids from socially marginalized families, and Class 4C works with seniors and mentally disabled people.

RESEARCH PROJECT: PHILANTHROPY IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC

In 2015 we published a research project on the state of philanthropy in the Czech Republic and the perception of philanthropy among leading figures in Czech society. We collaborated with the STEM agency and Via civic association (Sdružení Via, z. ú.) We provide the data to journalists and the broad public upon request.



TECHSOUP CZECH REPUBLIC

TechSoup develops the technological capacity of non-profit organizations and public libraries by providing access to donated software, hardware, IT services and related training. In 2015 we enabled gifts of software with a total market value exceeding CZK 50 million.

IT partners in the program:

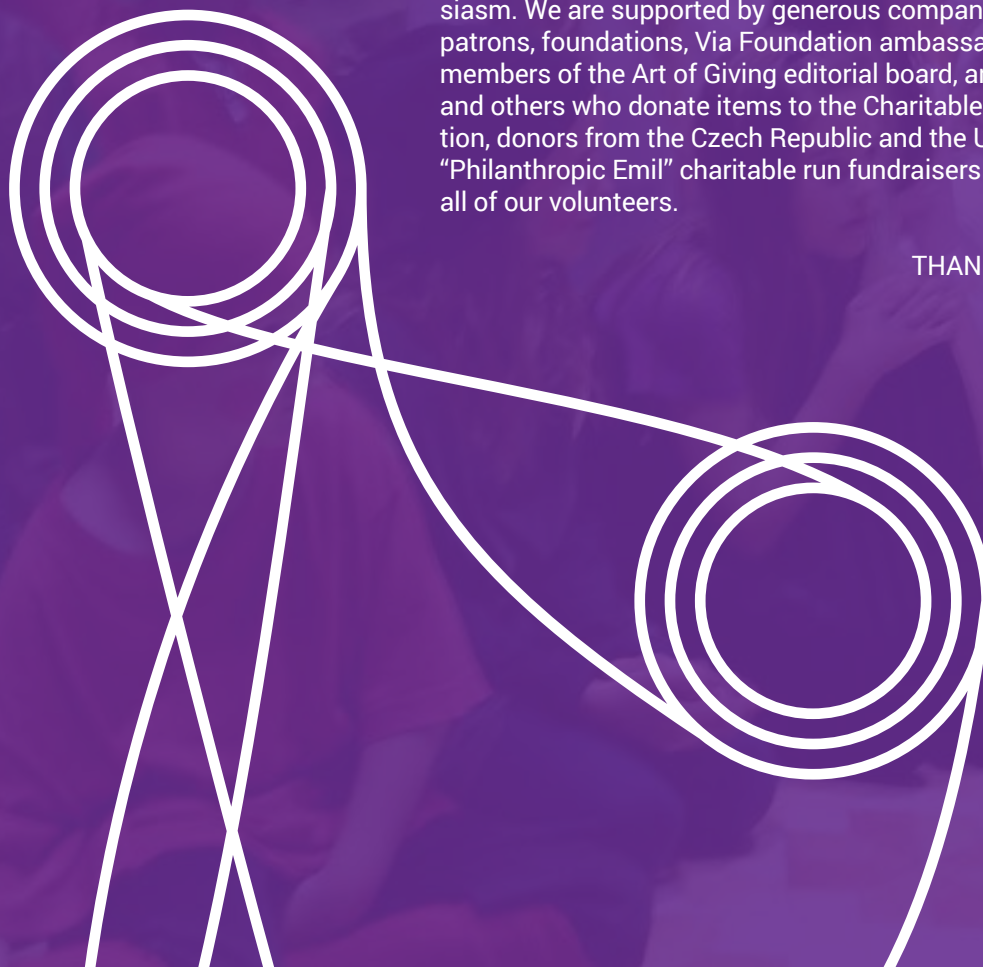

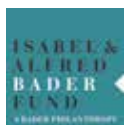

**DONOR PORTRAIT –
SILKE HORÁKOVÁ**

Silke Horáková is a private investor, co-owner of the publishing house Albatros Media a.s. and the executive director of the Czech Private Equity Association and Venture Capital. Silke supports social entrepreneurship, leads seminars about applying business principles in the social sector and serves as a mentor to social enterprises. In this field she works closely with Via Foundation, Ashoka, the Social Impact Award and other organizations. She and her husband recently founded Albatros Foundation, which supports education for socially disadvantaged children.

Silke has also been a Via Foundation donor for many years and we thank her for her support!

What led or inspired you to begin giving?

Essentially I began giving as a child, I was brought up that way. In school I tutored a little girl who was from a poor family. Since then I have understood how terribly important education is for such children – not just in terms of their chances to have a better life, but for their self-confidence as well.

And when I grew up and got to a place where I was able to help financially thanks to my background and education, and able to share my personal experience, I wanted to give something back to society.

For me, helping resolve problems in society is a strong motivation for giving – either directly, when I can contribute myself, or by supporting people who know how to do it better. That's why my husband and I recently founded Albatros Foundation, which aims to support education of socially disadvantaged children. We also supported the Institute of Active Citizenry in its work to educate volunteers helping refugees and of course Via Foundation.

How do you choose people or projects in which to invest with your gifts?

First and foremost, projects have to be in line with my personal values. There are so many people and projects deserving help. That's why one needs to

choose those who have the greatest social impact. For example, my husband and I support Ashoka, which supports social innovators, each of whom has a significant impact on resolving a problem in society.

We also devote a lot of time to projects where I can personally help with my experience in business, mostly in social entrepreneurship.

Why do you support Via Foundation?

Via Foundation supports values that are dear to me: social responsibility, philanthropy and preservation of cultural heritage. I see Via Foundation as a catalyst for social development with many years of experience. I can collaborate with Via Foundation on their social entrepreneurship support programs, participate in them directly. Their expertise helped us a lot with founding our own foundation, too. I've met many fantastic people at Via...

How do you perceive the word “philanthropist”?

To me, a philanthropist is someone who not only gives his or her financial resources and his or her money to address problems in society, but also lives his or her life in line with values that are good for society. It's about social responsibility, solidary and ethical business.

2015 CHARITABLE AUCTION

Guests at the 9th annual Via Foundation and South Moravian Community Foundation Charitable Auction bid on wines, artwork and experiences, raising a total of CZK 1,580,000. The auction was held in November at the Prague Marriott Hotel and was preceded by the second annual Pre-Auction Exhibition, which was held in October.

Over 80 items were donated to the auction, including wines from Czech and Moravian winemakers and artwork and design objects from leading Czech artists, designers and brands. The auction item that took in the highest bid was “Nothing”, which raised CZK 260,000. The work of artists Tomáš Němec, Josef Bolf and Křištof Kintera generated the most interest. The auction proceeds were used to support Via Foundation programs and operations.

FUNDRAISING RUNNERS FOR VIA FOUNDATION

Thanks to runners and “Philanthropic Emil” fundraising runners, we raised CZK 325,000 in 2015.

In 2015, we once again joined the popular Prague RunCzech races. A total of 245 runners ran on behalf of Via Foundation in the half-marathon, marathon and evening races. We raised CZK 82,000 from race fees. Twenty-seven runners took on the role of “Philanthropic Emils”, which means they fundraised from their friends and acquaintances, who donated through the Via Foundation on-line portal at www.kupsibezce.cz. Our 2015 Philanthropic Emils raised a total of CZK 243,800, which was matched by US-based Bader Philanthropies. These gifts are used to support community leaders addressing urgent local public interest issues through our Fast Grants program.

BENEFIT DINNER WITH RADEK JAROŠ

Via Foundation's 5th benefit dinner was hosted by the Hotel Radisson Blu Alcron, with leading Czech mountain climber Radek Jaroš as the guest speaker. Thanks to guests' gifts, we raised CZK 240,000, which we used to support our Viadukt educational program for emerging NGOs and to develop our fundraising and IT capacities.

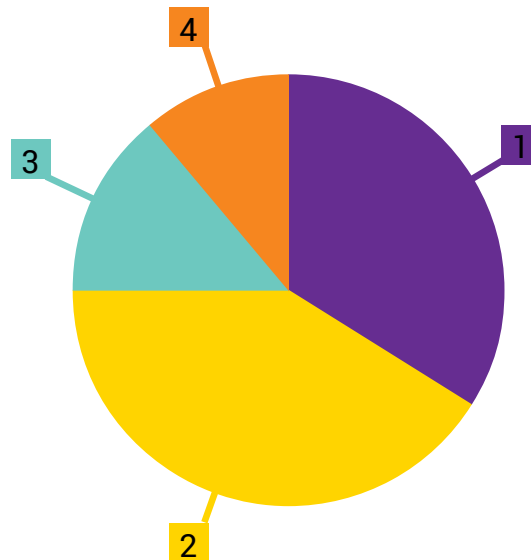
BREAKDOWN OF VIA FOUNDATION 2015 EXPENDITURES

Our annual budget and breakdown of expenditures reflects this programming focus and the way we work.

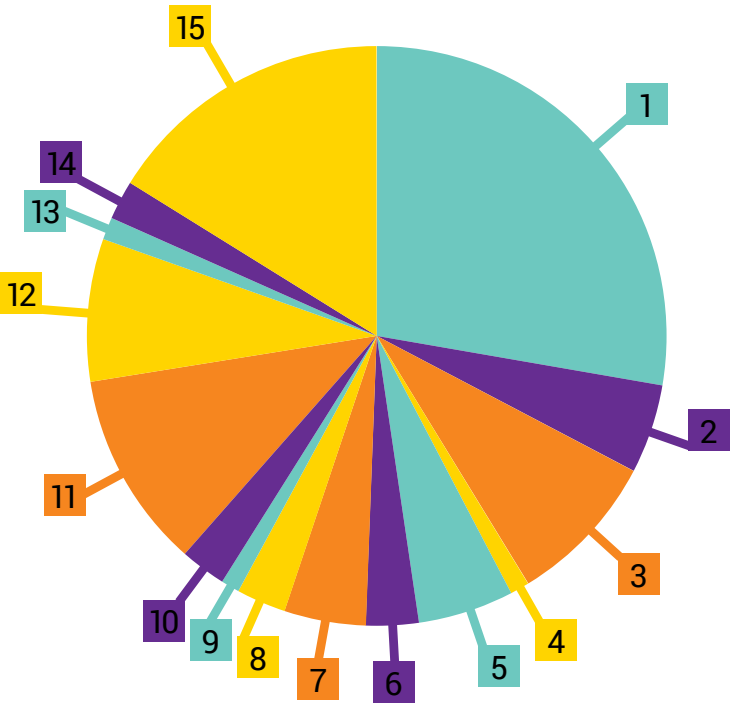
