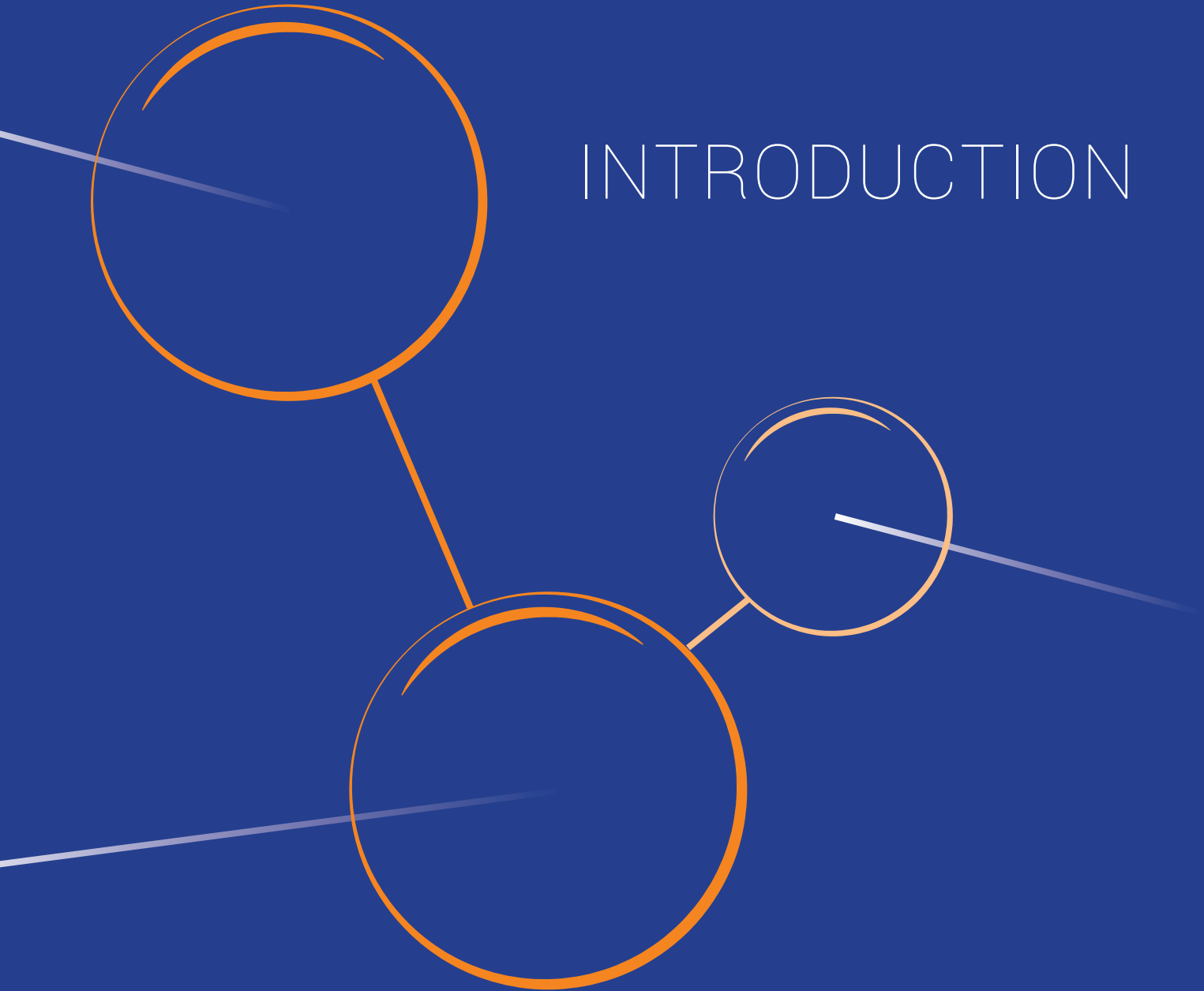

INTRODUCTION



Dear Friends,

Via Foundation views the world optimistically. Its objectives are both to solve problems and to look for opportunities, i.e. seeking out engaged people in the Czech Republic and abroad and helping them breathe life into their ideas to improve their communities and neighborhood relations, give to others effectively and build trust among people.

Since we have a chance through Via to meet with people who are full of energy and enthusiasm, we see many promising signs in the Czech Republic. For example, the number of people who are engaged in revitalizing Czech towns and villages is growing each year.

Via Foundation tries to meet their needs as comprehensively as possible – by awarding grants, connecting them to other likeminded individuals and guiding them to help make their projects successful.

To this end, Via Foundation developed and launched a new program titled Living Communities in 2016. The program is designed for engaged people and non-profit organizations which seek to revitalize their communities physically and/or socially. Our goal in the program is to be as open as possible: open to ideas and open to providing assistance that responds to people's immediate needs. We receive proposals for neighborhood festivals, community gardens, allees of trees, wayside chapel and cemetery renovation projects, community centers; in short, dozens of remarkable projects aiming to connect neighbors and improve their relations with one another.

Connection is another major theme at Via Foundation. In 2016, we held the first-ever international Community Forum, which brings together engaged people mainly from Central and Eastern Europe. One hundred people involved in community projects in their own countries took part in the three-day event.

Alongside our community focus, we support development of philanthropy and giving in the Czech Republic. Each year our Via Bona Philanthropy Awards recognize outstanding

philanthropists while the Young Philanthropists program helps children and young people discover philanthropy by helping them organize benefit events and matching what they raise.

Via Foundation also helped develop Via Clarita, a new organization whose mission is to provide philanthropy advising services and cultivate the philanthropic environment in the Czech Republic. It is a unique project that will provide services that are in increasing demand among Czech philanthropists.

Via Foundation is also introducing tools that make giving in the Czech Republic easier. Thanks to the online Darujme.cz service, people gave roughly CZK 28 million (\$1,287,317) to charity – an increase of 25% year-on-year. Due to this growing interest, Via Foundation decided to upgrade Darujme.cz and in 2016 we devoted considerable energy to developing a new version, which enables individuals to set up fundraising drives themselves. Anyone can set up a donor profile on the site and raise money for charity from friends and acquaintances – for example, asking for a donation instead of a tangible birthday present.

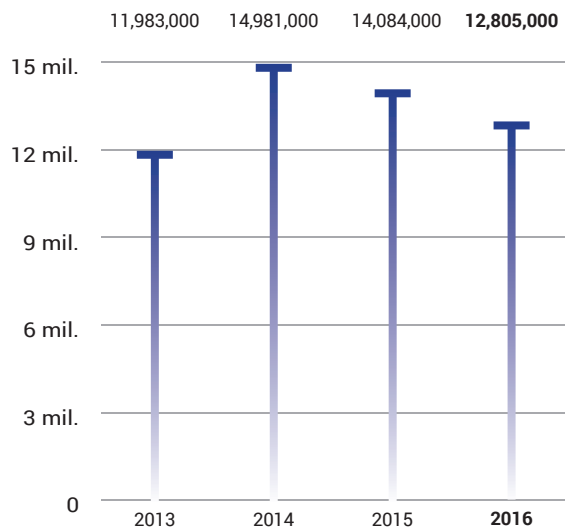
Via Foundation looks forward to its 20th year with the hope that giving and community stewardship in the Czech Republic will continue to grow.

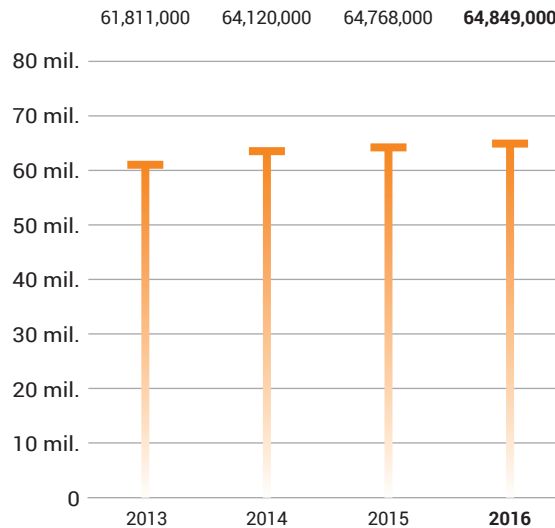

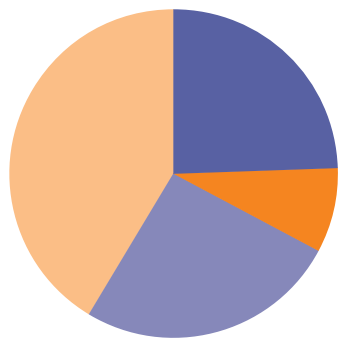
2016 IN FIGURES



In 2016 we awarded **CZK 12,805,506** (\$583,036) in grants.

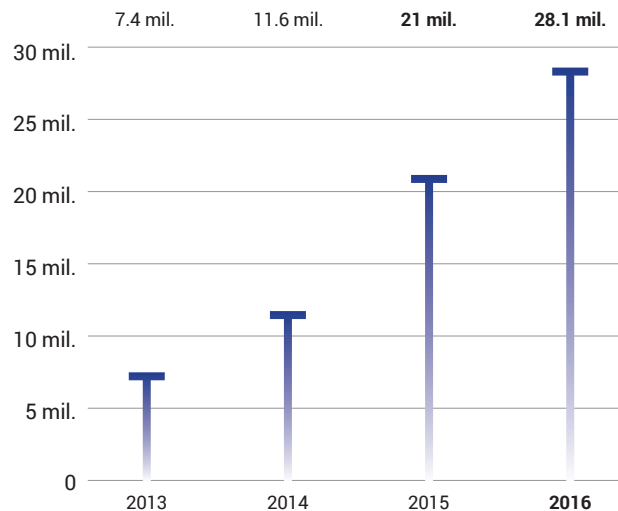


Thanks to the trust our donors place in us, our endowment grew to **CZK 64,849,000** (\$2,952,584) in 2016.



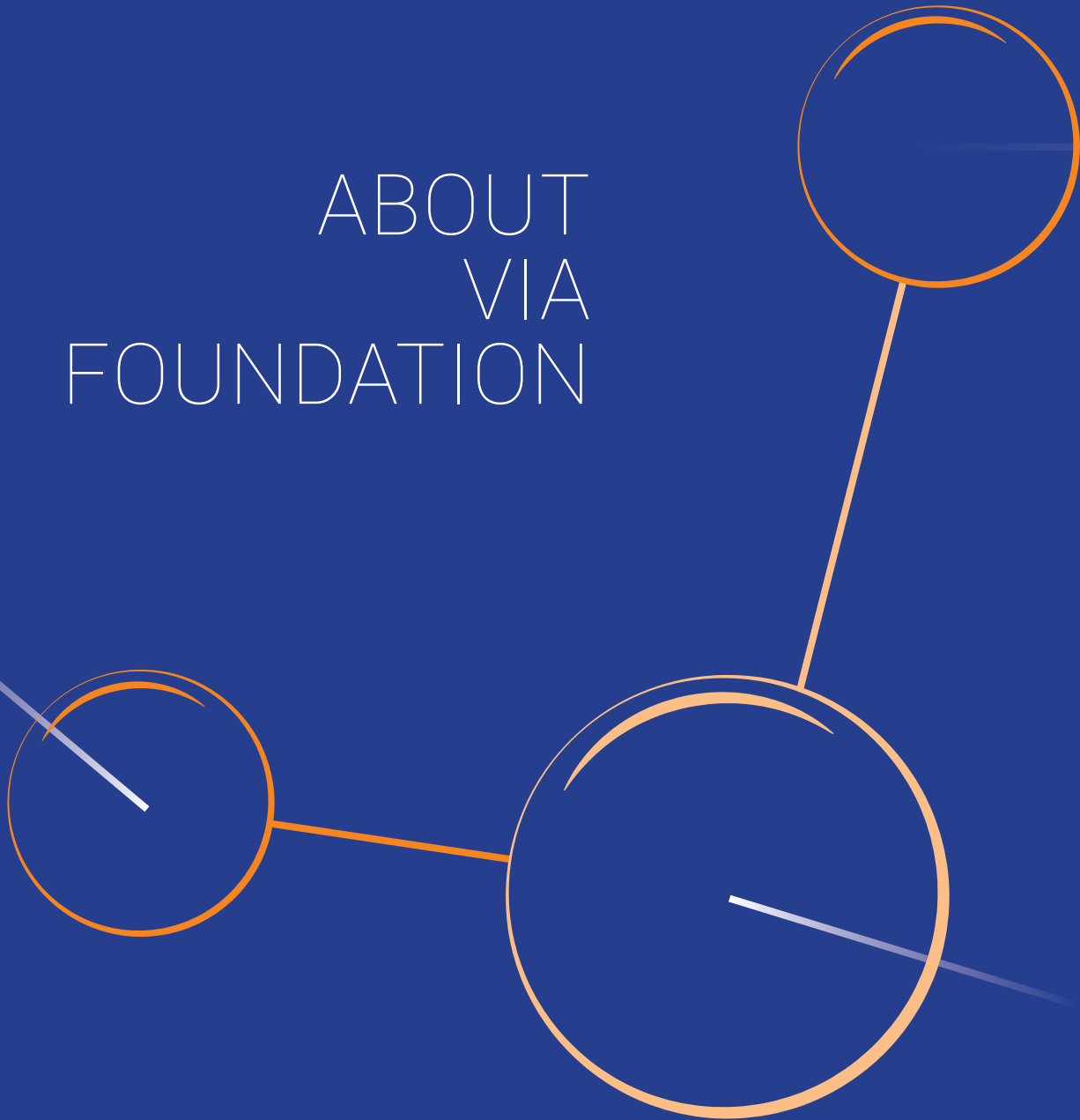

OUR MISSION

Spread the art of giving and the art of co-existing together in the Czech Republic.

OUR VISION

Our vision is a society in which people act freely and courageously, accept responsibility for themselves and their community, and where giving is a regular part of life.

We believe that we can fulfill this vision by focusing on community and philanthropy development.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND THE ART OF CO-EXISTING TOGETHER

We develop community. We seek out, connect and support individuals and groups of people changing their communities for the better. We support people who take the initiative themselves rather than waiting for others to intervene; people who work together to make Czech cities and towns come alive again. Specifically, people who transform and revitalize public spaces, restore neglected small monuments or organize neighborhood gatherings – shaping community life and doing whatever is needed in their communities to bring people together.

PHILANTHROPY DEVELOPMENT AND THE ART OF GIVING

We develop philanthropy. Via seeks to make giving, charity, generosity and caring for others a normal and regular part of life in the Czech Republic. We raise awareness about giving and recognize individuals and companies for their philanthropy. We help children and students organize benefit events, leading them towards philanthropy from an early age. We also develop online giving in the Czech Republic.

OUR HISTORY

We are an independent Czech foundation. We raise money from individual donors, companies, foundations and our endowment revenues; we do not use funding from European Union or state funds. We have a team of 20 employees. Via was established in 1997 to carry on the work of the Czech office of the American Foundation for a Civil Society. Since then we have supported almost 4,000 projects. Since 2005 our partner organizations - Friends of Via in Pittsburgh and Via civic association and Via Clarita in Prague - have complemented the work of Via Foundation.



HOW WE HELP

We fulfill Via Foundation's vision through programming which supports engaged people in the Czech Republic and abroad. This section provides an overview and examples of supported projects.

We provide both grants and operational support in our programs in an effort to support engaged people with more than money by offering them opportunities to learn and connect with each other.

Our fields of interest are what we call the art of co-existing together (community development) and the art of giving (philanthropy development). Our community development programs support civic engagement in communities with the aim of bringing people together on a local level. Our philanthropy development programs seek to cultivate a culture of giving in the Czech Republic.

THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH WE LIVE

Bečice is a typical South Bohemian village near Tábor with a population of 108. The village commons in front of the municipal hall was largely unused for decades, until local residents, spurred by the mayor's initiative, decided to work together to transform the site.

We supported the community with a grant and assistance. A series of community meetings was held where dozens of local residents debated the function of the site and worked with an architect on the site plan. In the spring residents came together again, this time for work parties through which they built a community gazebo, installed a small playground and planted trees.

About our support:

We gave the community a grant of CZK 300,000 (\$13,659). We also provided guidance through the community planning, build and grand opening phases of the project. The project team also took part in workshops and connected with program participants from other communities.

About the program:

We select a number of organizations or municipalities in The Community in Which We Live program and support them

with a grant, workshops and ongoing consultations. We guide them through the entire process to enable community members to revitalize the given public space according to their needs. We also guide them in learning to work together to avoid potential conflicts and developing new relations within the community.

LIVING COMMUNITIES

Too bad that hardly anyone plants allees of trees to improve the landscape anymore, thought residents in Dobroslavice in the Ostrava region. The members of a local association researched old maps and found that there used to be a path leading from three linden trees located on a hill above their town, a site which offers a great view of the surrounding Silesian countryside. The site is currently accessed via a field. They decided to create a new allee along the old pathway.

They staked the tree locations and engaged neighbors in re-pairing the old path leading to the three linden trees and a cross.

About our support:

We awarded a grant for tree planting and renovations, connected them with an experienced mentor and included them in a training seminar where fledgling non-profit organizations learn how to engage citizens and raise funds for community projects.

About the program:

Living Communities is a new Via Foundation program that supports engaged people seeking to improve their community. The program objectives are to enhance the phys-

ical and/or social community environment, improve relations and help communities become more self-reliant. We launched the program in fall 2016, initially collaborating with Plzeňský Prazdroj on a special grant call for volunteer fire brigades.

FAST GRANTS

Closed for years, the outdoor swimming pool facility in Úvaly u Prahy gradually began to fall into disrepair. The local government refused to fund repairs due to the cost, claiming that reconstructing the swimming pool would drain funding from other needed repair work. An association of residents was convinced that the repairs could be managed at a reasonable cost and without infringing on other repair expenditures.

The future of the swimming pool was finally decided via a referendum, which saw a 5% higher turnout than the last local elections.

Three-quarters of those who cast their ballots voted to save the swimming pool. The referendum results are binding and the association is now seeking to work with the town on the pool reconstruction project. The pool is scheduled to re-open next year.

About our support:

A Fast Grant of CZK 20,000 (\$900) was used for a public information campaign about the referendum.

About the program:

The Fast Grants program supports community groups addressing urgent local public interest issues. Common Fast Grant issues include inefficiency in local government, wasting of public resources, construction of unsuitable buildings and air and noise pollution. We also bring Fast Grants project leaders together through our Citizen Activists Club, where they can exchange experiences and glean inspiration from one another. Fast Grants also includes the 'Rescue Ranger' component, which is comprised of a consultant team that provides customized advisory services for selected projects.

CULTURAL HERITAGE FUND

The Žlutice Association 2000 in South Bohemia strives to cultivate the landscape by building new walking trails and renovating small monuments, including this small cross that used to stand near the municipality of Žlutice. It had originally been made by a local blacksmith.

The Žlutice Association 2000 decided to relocate the cross a short distance away from its original location. In November the local pastor christened the cross at a small ceremony accompanied by a performance by local music students. The association also renovates other small monument in the vicinity and as the members like to say, their efforts have many positive and diverse impacts: the monuments are a popular destination for school groups, teachers use them as a learning tool and children talk about the crosses and statues and research their history.

About our support:

We gave the Žlutice Association a grant of CZK 26,760 (\$1,100) for renovation of the Neumann Cross.

About the program:

The program objective is to help people strengthen their bonds to their community and to one another through collaborative restoration of small monuments. Aside from facilitating restoration of monuments, we seek to help resi-

dents discover the history of their communities, build new relationships and strengthen existing friendships.

T-MOBILE FUND

HELPING THROUGH STORIES AND VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

In collaboration with Via Foundation, T-Mobile supports its employees in their charitable efforts. Like every year, in 2016 Helping through Stories gave T-Mobile employees a chance to donate to charitable projects at the beginning of the holiday season. T-Mobile matched the proceeds with a gift of CZK 503,530 (\$23,000). This enabled us to award CZK 1,032,260 (\$47,000) in January 2016 to support people in crisis. The grantees were nominated by T-Mobile employees.

In autumn 2016, T-Mobile recognized employees involved in charitable efforts. These employees were given the opportunity to support community organizations in which they serve as volunteers. A total of 7 organizations were supported with CZK 50,000 (\$2,280).

LET'S TALK

Markoušovice is a small village in the Podkrkonoš foothills. Having lacked a village commons for many years, local residents decided to build one themselves. Dozens of people came together for community planning meetings.

They built benches and a new bell tower and planted trees. The site is intended as a new meeting place with a gazebo and a playground. The project helped spark a new sense of community in the village.

About our support:

We awarded a grant of CZK 100,000 (\$4,572), which was used for the renovation project.

About program:

The key themes of this program are communication, collaboration and integration. Along with grants, we provided the supported organizations with an opportunity to participate in free training through the T-Mobile Fund Acad-

emy, through which T-Mobile employees provide expert advisory services, practical one-day workshops and webinars and volunteer assistance.

BETTER BUSINESS

Ten years ago, Zdeňka Palátová lost her hearing. She had to give up her shop due to her disability and had trouble finding work. She then founded a non-profit organization called Vrátka, used her savings to buy a newsstand for the association and hired her first employee.

Today, Vrátka's breadth of activity makes it a unique social enterprise in the Czech Republic. It operates newsstands, a bakery, a caf, a second hand clothing store and other small shops. The enterprise has more than 30 employees with various disabilities ranging from hearing and vision impairments to mental disabilities.

About our support:

We awarded the project a grant of CZK 330,000 (\$15,000), which was used to renovate the bakery premises. Our support also included a series of training seminars about finances, marketing and other relevant topics and the services of a consultant.

About the program:

Better Business supports entrepreneurs who seek to make positive social changes through their work. Our goal is to support social enterprises that have social, environmental, community and economic benefits for our society.

VIADUCT

A group of five volunteers saved a two-hundred year old school in Vranov nad Vltavou from complete dilapidation. Over the past four years the group has made the former school a community center used by boy scouts, senior citizens, dance groups, children, artists, musicians and soldiers.

Anna Lupienska is one of the volunteers. She devotes about one day a week to working in the old school. In 2016 she took part in our educational program Viaduct, which helps people from small non-profit organizations learn how to engage others in their activities, raise awareness about their work and raise money.

About our support:

We provided a series of educational workshops on topics such as organizational vision and mission, fundraising and engaging the public.

About the program:

Viaduct is designed to provide learning opportunities to people from non-profit organizations and others who want to improve their communities. The program has several pillars: Guide, Collection and Advisor. Guide serves to help fledgling organizations, Collection includes workshops on community topics and Advisor offers IT train-

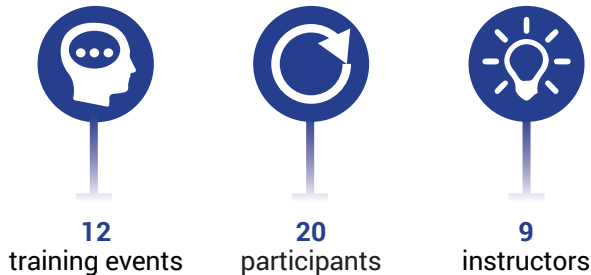
ing. The program also includes our ViaCafé, which is an informal gathering of people who are engaged in their communities.

VIABILITYNET 2.0 AND THE COMMUNITY FORUM

One hundred people from all over Europe came to Prague in April 2016 for the first international Community Forum. They were joined by Elena Madison, an urban planner from New York. The Forum included a number of workshops in which participants shared their experiences with revitalizing communities.

It was our first time holding the Community Forum. It was an important part of our international program ViabilityNet 2.0., through which we supported individuals in Central and Eastern Europe who were engaging their community in revitalization efforts.

We supported 31 community leaders through ViabilityNet 2.0 in 2015 with CZK 1,800,000 (\$82,000).

In 2016 the program continued with a series of educational workshops and the Community Forum.

About the program:

ViabilityNet 2.0 supported and connected engaged leaders from Central and Eastern Europe striving to make tangible positive changes in their communities. In 2016 the pro-

gram included educational workshops, the Community Forum and participants' local community projects.

DARUJME.CZ

In 2016 people donated more than CZK 28 million (\$1,287,317) through the online Darujme.cz service, which was CZK 7 million more than in 2015.

Darujme.cz is a service that enables non-profit organizations to benefit from online giving. By using this service, they avoid having to run their own payment portal. More than 260 non-profit organizations in the Czech Republic use Darujme.cz, including some of the largest non-profit organizations, such as People in Need and Doctors without Borders.

Darujme.cz also provides us with interesting data: for example, December is traditionally the month in which people give the most. The biggest giving day in 2016 was November 29, which was the first-ever Giving Tuesday in the Czech Republic.

About the program:

Darujme.cz is an online fundraising tool for non-profit organizations. It enables them to reach out to new and current donors and ask for gifts in an easy way online, either through a giving widget on the web or through an email campaign or a web application. Darujme.cz is intended for non-anonymous individual gifts.

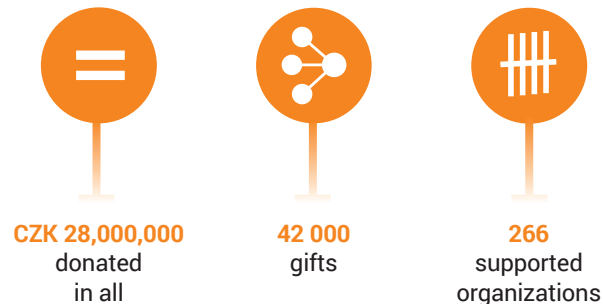

PHILANTHROPISTS, JR./BE HELPFUL

Jiří Boháč is bound to a wheelchair. A group of students from a Prague high school organized a benefit event to raise money to buy materials that will make Mr. Boháč's life easier.

And it wasn't just any old benefit event. No one was wearing a race jersey or running shoes. Each person was dressed as if s/he had to catch a train on the way to school or work – with the train already pulling out of the station. People wore suits, skirts, carried backpacks full of school-books or gym bags. The run caught the media's attention and the group raised CZK 10,888 (\$500) from participants' voluntary contributions.

About our support:

We helped the students plan the benefit event and we also matched the funds they raised. Thanks to the run, the students and Via and ČSOB bank donated a total of CZK 21,776 (\$1,000) to Jiří Boháč.

About the program:

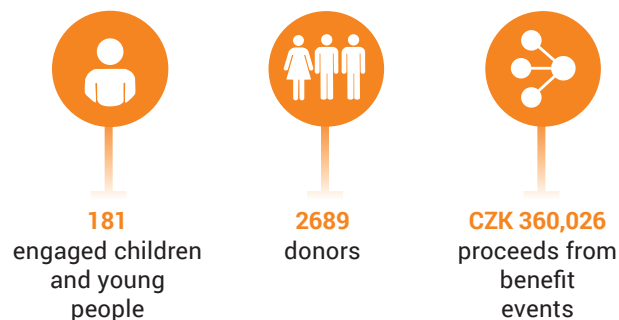
The program supports groups of children and young people who raise money for charitable causes. We give them funding and learning opportunities.

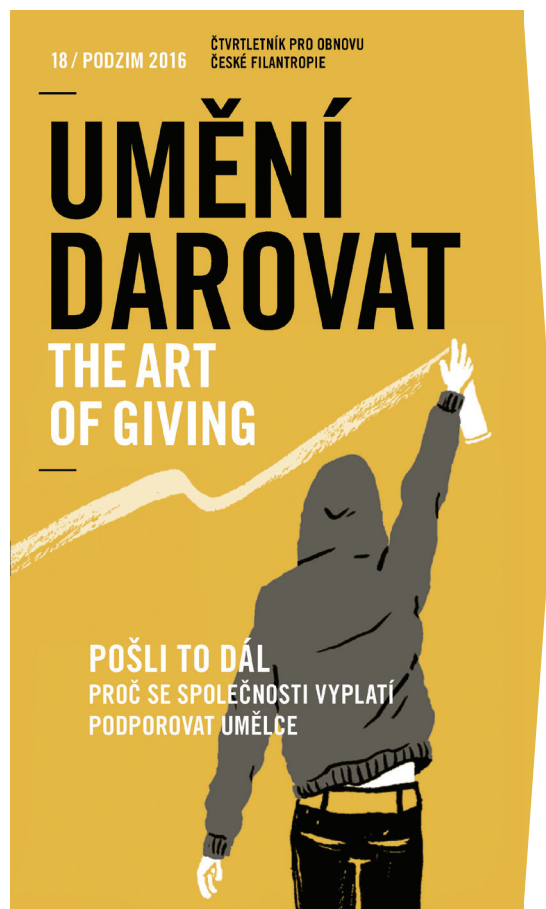

VIA BONA PHILANTHROPY AWARDS

Although Zdeňka Mocňáková has been in a wheelchair since she was 25, she devotes her free time to helping senior and disabled citizens. In the town of Louny, she established a Senior taxi service for people who have trouble getting around. The service is such a success that it has inspired a number of cities in different parts of the Czech Republic to set up their own Senior taxi services.

Zdeňka Mocňáková was one of our Via Bona Philanthropy Award winners in 2016. We present the awards each year to Czech philanthropists who give their time, energy or money to help others. Our goal is to show that each and every one of us can be a philanthropist.

In 2016 we awarded Via Bona Philanthropy Awards in the following categories:

Personal Engagement and Public's Choice Award:

Zdeňka Mocňáková

In addition to the Senior taxi service, Zdeňka Mocňáková has raised awareness about the issues that disabled people face for almost 30 years through the Union of the Physically Disabled.

Young Philanthropist Personal Engagement Award:

Milan Dzuriak and Jakub Trefný

Milan Dzuriak used to be a competitive athlete and dreamed of taking part in the Olympics. Health problems abruptly ended his career, but rather than letting that defeat him, he turned to philanthropy. He undertook a Journey Against Pain and raised money to fulfill the dreams of two disabled boys.

Jakub Trefný regularly visits senior citizens in retirement homes, takes part in Christmas luncheons for the homeless, organizes collections for the needy and even travels abroad to help war refugees. His charitable work has inspired many of his schoolmates and young people in his community.

Good Company Award:

Dušan Hopp, auto Díly Servis s.r.o.

Over the past few years, Dušan Hopp, owner of auto Díly Servis, has raised money and coordinated volunteers to renovate an asylum home for pregnant women in crisis. He and other volunteers help in the daily operations of the home as well. Dušan Hopp is proof that even small companies in industries not commonly associated with charity work can do good.



Patron Award:

Sanjiv Suri

Sanjiv Suri, owner of Zátíší Group, invited guests at his birthday party to make a donation to People in Need's project in Cambodia rather than giving him a present. He matched the funds raised. He also rode 850 km on a bike in his native India to raise money for the NGO Doctors without Borders. Sanjiv Suri engages his friends in his philanthropic work and through his own involvement he helps cultivate the culture of giving in the Czech Republic.

Loyal Donor Award:

Asaf Auerbach

Asaf Auerbach is following in the footsteps of the man who saved his life, Sir Nicholas Winton. Owing to Sir Winton's courage, Asaf Auerbach survived World War II. He now helps children in crisis himself. For the past nine years, he has donated two-thirds of his orphan pension to help children in the poorest countries of the world.

Bequeath Award:

Ludmila Šilhánková

Ludmila Šilhánková bequeathed over CZK 2 million to support educational and recreational activities for disabled children and young people. Despite her own disability she became a recognized micro-biologist in her lifetime.

OTHER EVENTS IN 2016

VIA CLARITA

In August 2016 the Via Clarita Endowment Fund (Nadační fond Via Clarita) was established to build on Via Foundation's 20 years of experience in philanthropy.

The objectives of the Fund are to provide philanthropy advising services and to cultivate the philanthropic environment of the Czech Republic. Via Clarita seeks to introduce a broader and more strategic view of individual giving to the Czech Republic.

VIA CLARITA

PHILANTHROPIST DOCUMENTARY FILM SERIES

In autumn 2016 Czech TV aired a thirteen-part documentary series about philanthropists. The project was conceived by director Jana Počtová, who sought to present contemporary Czech philanthropists, various forms of philanthropy and how philanthropy is perceived by the Czech public. The series also sought to show how people who are engaged in their communities perceive the world around them and its problems and how they invest their own resources to help others. Via Foundation was the expert guarantor of the TV series.

MR. AND MRS. HORA FUND

Marie Horová and Václav Hora founded a donor fund to help children in the Carpatho-Ukraine in 2005. Mrs. Horová also bequeathed funds in her will to help children in her native land. In autumn 2016 the fund's selection committee awarded support to 7 projects in a total amount of CZK 377,000. This grant round utilized the last of the fund's resources, thus concluding the fund and fulfilling Mrs. Horová's last wishes.

RACHŮNEK FUND

Marek Herman established this donor fund in 2006. Since then, Marek and dozens of his students have donated more than CZK 500,000 to the fund. It is a permanent fund, which means that only the fund yields are used to support educational and development projects for parents caring for children under the age of six. THREE SISTERS ARE HELPING FUND

The music band Three Sisters established a donor fund at VIA Foundation in 2011. 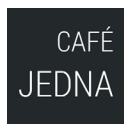

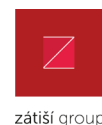

A second aspect is the understanding that I gained the knowledge and skills I have thanks to people who were willing to share their own wisdom. And that's just one little step away from not keeping it for myself, sharing it with people around me without any personal gain. That's why I view philanthropy as more than transferring money to support projects that are non-profit, to me it is also engaging in projects to which I can give my time and expertise.

How do you decide which projects to support?

I like to take indirect paths in life. That's why my support does not focus primarily on humanitarian and social areas, which often inspire people to give because of empathy and belonging. I am glad that affluent donors and individuals support these areas. I like the idea that even the major-

ity society and "ordinary" people deserve attention. That's why I feel that supporting civic engagement, communities, development of critical thinking skills and of philanthropy cultivates Czech society. That makes life better for all of us and indirectly increases support to the needy in the areas I mentioned earlier.

Why do you support Via Foundation?

In the beginning it was partially a coincidence, when I learned about Via Foundation from someone whose opinion I really value. The staff at Via then helped me and inspired me in my thinking about whom I could support and how. I know from my own experience that it is not easy to go from a general willingness to help in some way to the specific decision to support a selected project. Another important point was that we share values and an understanding of who to support and how.

What do you think most inspires other people you know to give?

I believe that the strongest inspiration comes from positive examples from those we trust. I help run a small construction company and realize how important it is to develop the company culture and for management to set a good example.

VIA FOUNDATION BENEFIT EVENTS

Every year we hold several benefit events which help us raise money to fund our programs and which also give us an opportunity to meet our donors and other interesting people – enlightened philanthropists, business people, company owners and artists, for example. We thank everyone who supported our Charitable Auction in any way, took part in a benefit dinner or organized a fundraising drive for Via Foundation.

2016 CHARITABLE AUCTION

The tenth annual Via Foundation Charitable Auction took place in November 2016 at the Prague Marriott Hotel. We raised a record **CZK 2,906,000**. Almost 100 artists, designers, Czech brands, winemakers and others donated items to the auction.

One of the auction items that got the highest bid amount was “Nothing”, which raised CZK 200,000. The painting *Lion Bowl* by Pasta Oner, a dinner with the Karpíškovi and a day of work at Via Foundation went for the same price. The auction proceeds were used to support philanthropy and communities in the Czech Republic and to develop Via Foundation’s fundraising.

We thank everyone who donated an auction item as well as our financial partners, those who donated services, bidders and everyone else who helped make the 2016 auction a success.

BENEFIT DINNER WITH JAN KRAUS

The sixth Via Foundation benefit dinner took place in September 2016. The special guest was actor and talk show host Jan Kraus. The dinner was made possible through the generous support of the Radisson Blu Alcron Hotel. The dinner guests donated a total of **CZK 134,000**, which was used to support young philanthropists and their own benefit events through our Young Philanthropists program and to strengthen Via’s fundraising.



WE LAUNCHED PEER 2 PEER FUNDRAISING DRIVES!

Over the past few years a group of runners has formed around Via Foundation, who participate in Prague runs on a regular basis and fundraise among their friends or co-workers for our advocacy and anti-corruption program Fast Grants. In 2016 there was a half-marathon, marathon and September evening run in Prague and thanks to our fundraising runners' efforts, a total of **CZK 494,644** (\$22,323) was raised.

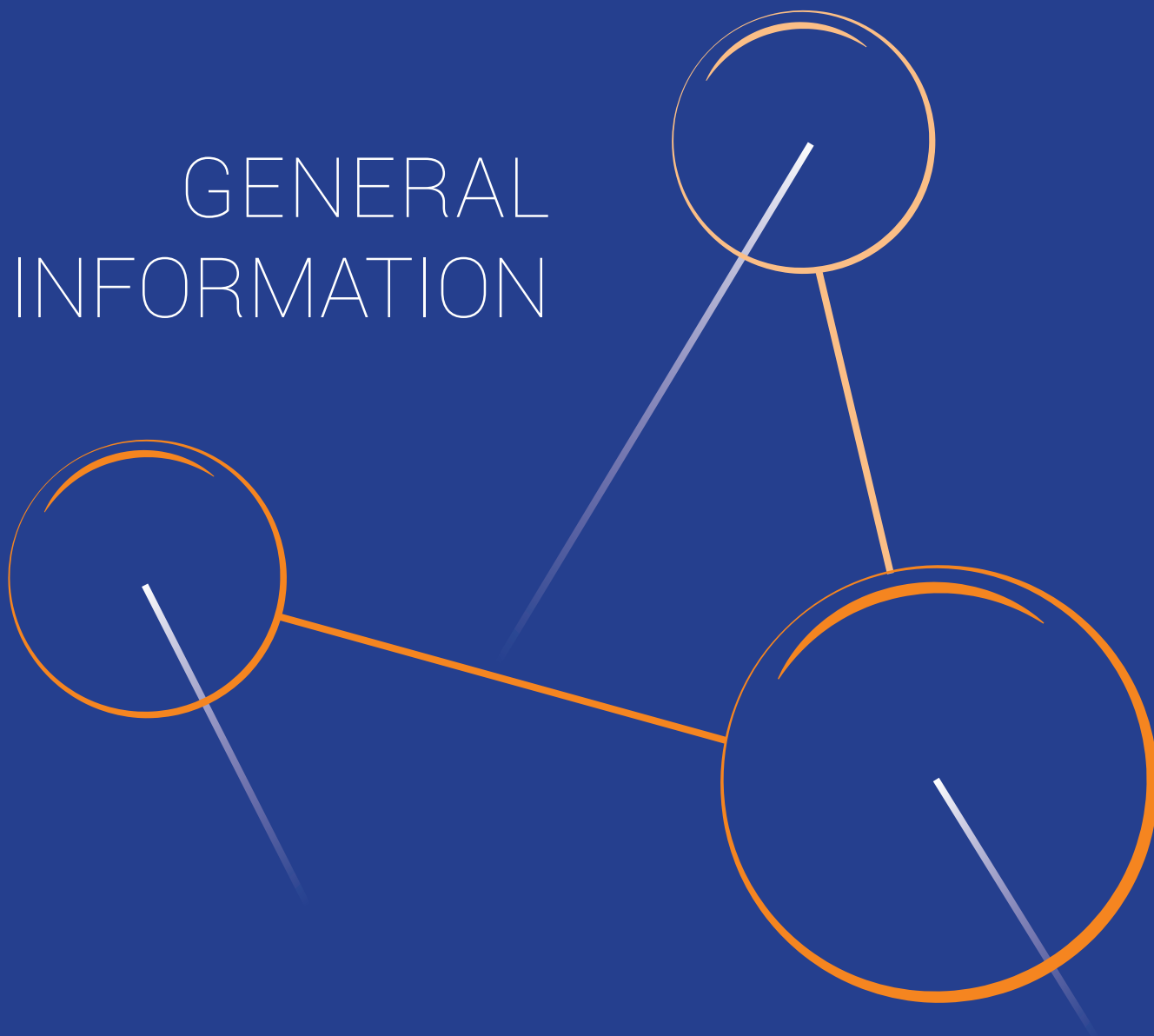
Another peer 2 peer fundraising event was the **Kohák group fundraising drive** (Jakub Kohák, Tomáš Šebek, Jiří Hölzel, Michal Novotný), who decided to help Via Bona Philanthropy Awardwinner Zdenka Mocňáková and raised a total of **CZK 40,689** to buy her a new wheelchair.

Another fundraising drive for Via was held by **Sanjiv Suri**. In late 2016 and early 2017, he raised **CZK 424,167** (\$19,200) and made a commitment to make the total **CZK 1,200,000** (\$54,000) in a two-year timeframe. The money is going to our Young Philanthropists' program, which guides children and young people in discovering philanthropy through organizing benefit events.

Our annual budget and breakdown of expenditures reflect this programming focus and the way we work.

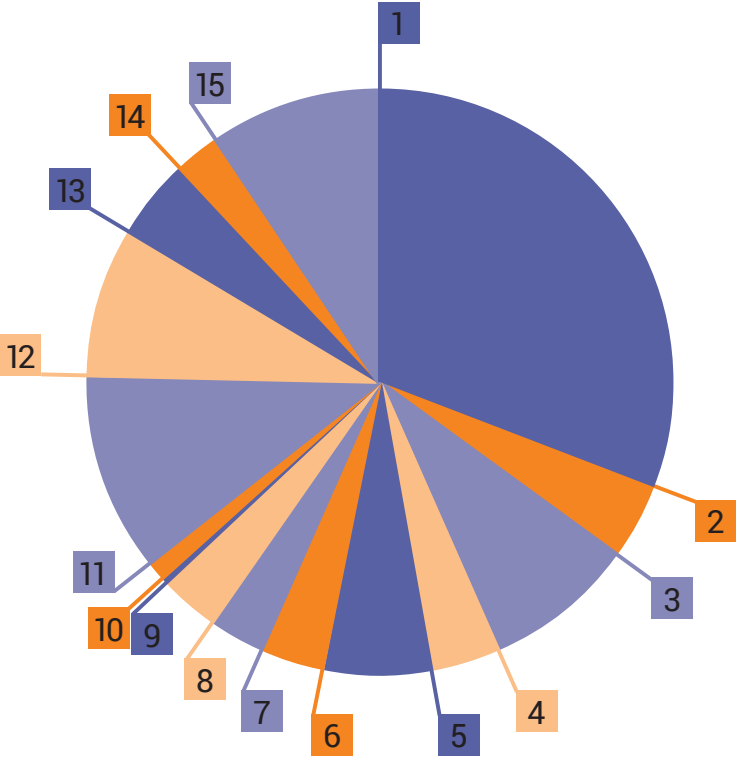

Výrok auditora
