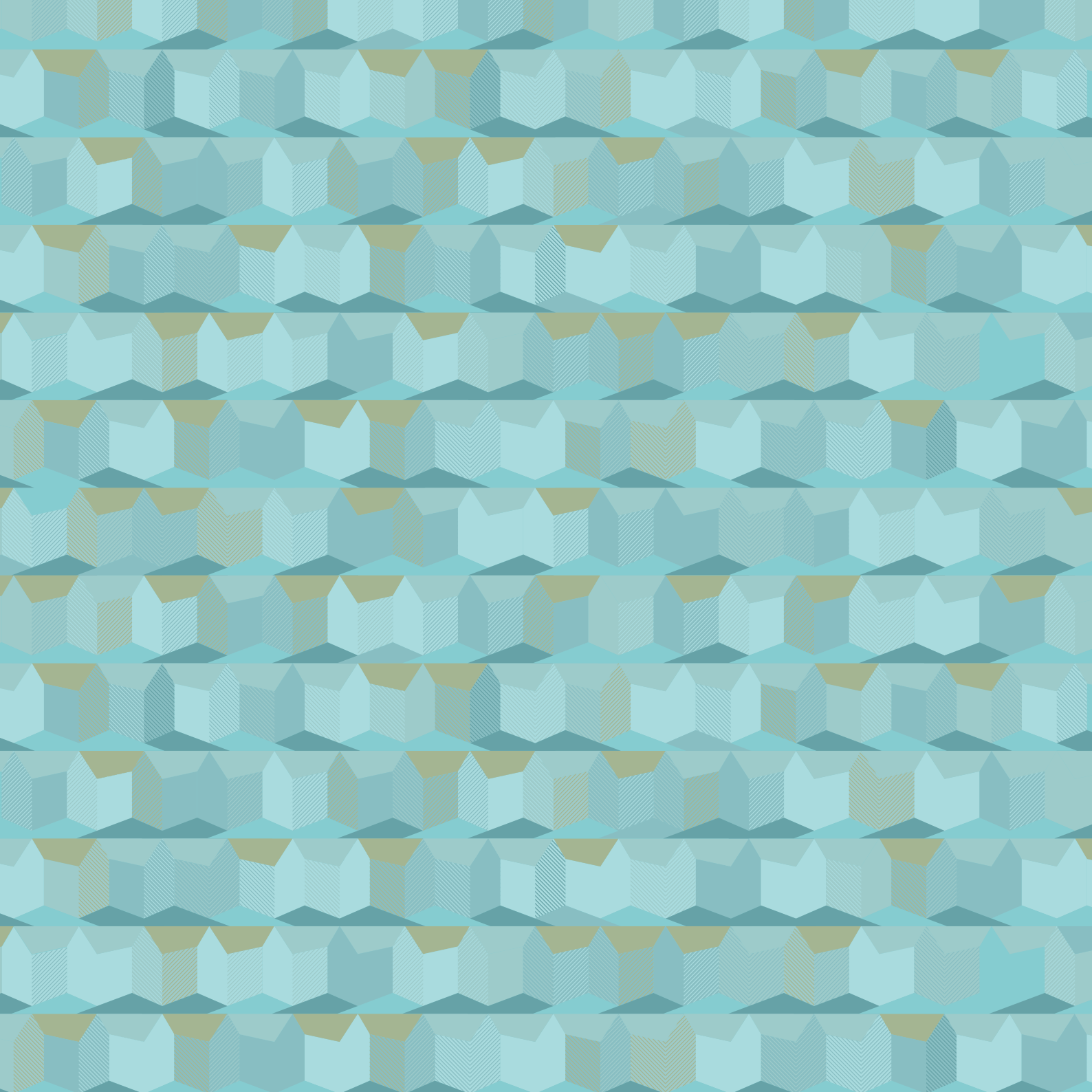

RENEWING HOPE IN SOCIETY TOGETHER



In January 1997, Prague native Madeleine Albright became the US Secretary of State. Just a few months later Via Foundation was founded. Back then we believed the medicine to cure the ills totalitarianism had wrought in Czech society lay in renewing community life and philanthropy. For a society in which the right to associate had been suppressed for 50 years, it was no easy task.

Although the world has changed dramatically since then, Via Foundation's themes remain key. We still find many places in the Czech Republic where time seems to have stopped – people don't know or trust one another, they have no places to gather as a community, many are apathetic about life beyond their front doors and few believe that they have the power to change anything.

It's no wonder, then, that 55% of adults in the Czech Republic are not engaged in their communities and the level of trust between people is significantly lower than in societies without a totalitarian past. Moreover, these old scars are now compounded by new challenges – we live closed off in our own thought bubbles, in the same world but with little understanding and in fact chasms are growing between liberals and conservatives, city dwellers and villagers, long-time residents and newcomers, and people who look forward to a technology-based future and those who fear what this future holds.

At Via Foundation, we are convinced that in this current climate it makes sense to keep looking for ways to engage fellow citizens and grow philanthropy. Through our years of work at the foundation, we know that only when people meet and get to know each other on a personal level can they begin approaching each other's thought bubbles. And only after that can they glimpse the world through the eyes of those who are on the other side of the chasms dividing society. And there lies the hope that we can learn to live side by side.

Via Foundation is an independent Czech foundation established in 1997. We do not use funding from European Union or government funds; we rely solely on individual donors, companies, foundations and revenues from our endowment fund. We have 21 employees.

Via Foundation's work is complemented by its sister organizations: Friends of Via in Pittsburgh, VIA civic association and Via Clarita endowment.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT: THE ART OF CO-EXISTING TOGETHER

We develop community. We support people who are changing their communities for the better by revitalizing public spaces, restoring small monuments, sparking community life in Czech towns or organizing neighborhood festivals. We support them with grants, consultations and learning opportunities to help them learn to care for the community they share, work together and strengthen their relationships.

PHILANTHROPY DEVELOPMENT: THE ART OF GIVING

We develop philanthropy. Via seeks to make giving, charity, generosity and caring for others a normal and regular part of life in the Czech Republic. We raise awareness about giving and recognize individuals and companies for their philanthropy. We help children and students organize benefit events, leading them towards philanthropy from an early age. We also develop online giving in the Czech Republic.

WHO WE WORK WITH MOST

• **Children and young people**

Children and young people are the least affected by negative opinions or experiences from the past. Giving them a positive first-hand experience with philanthropy and volunteering in their communities can awaken a lifelong interest in the world around them. They also pass on their positive emotions to their parents.



• **People who are engaged in their communities**

A group of 5 to 7 engaged people is enough to ignite community life and sustain it. And if engaged people work with local natural authorities like teachers, priests, business people, doctors and volunteer firefighters, their activities can affect a large part of the community.



• **Mayors and councilors**

Their decisions have a significant impact on the quality of life in towns. By opening their minds to working with others and learning to engage citizens in public life, they can transform the atmosphere in their towns and help grow true communities based on good neighborly relations.

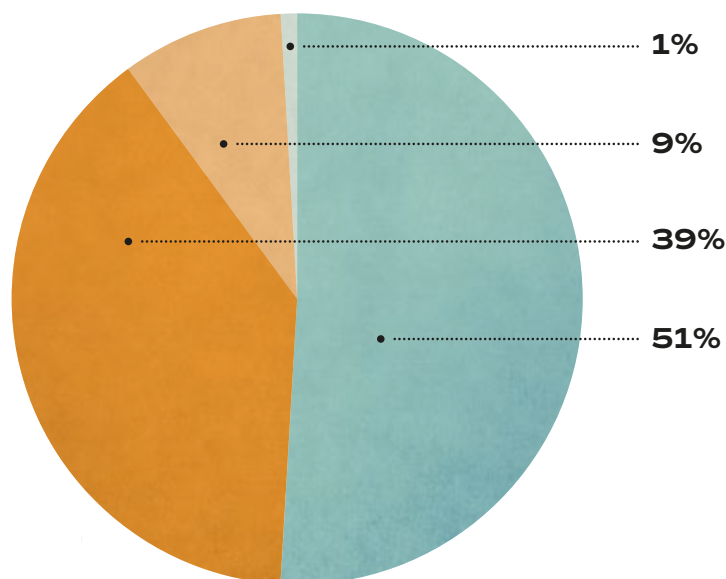
Between 2018 and 2021 we will focus on communities of up to 10,000 inhabitants and city districts.

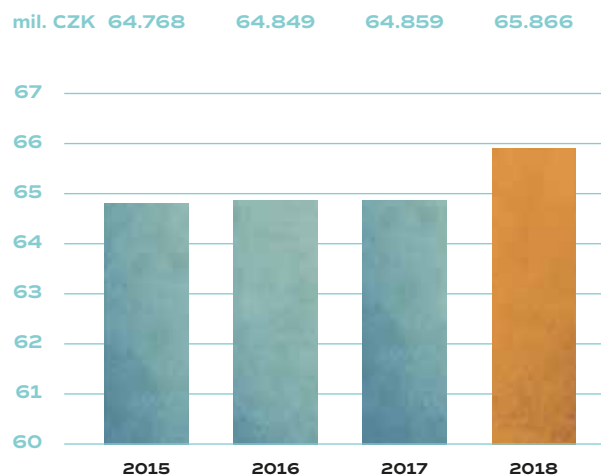
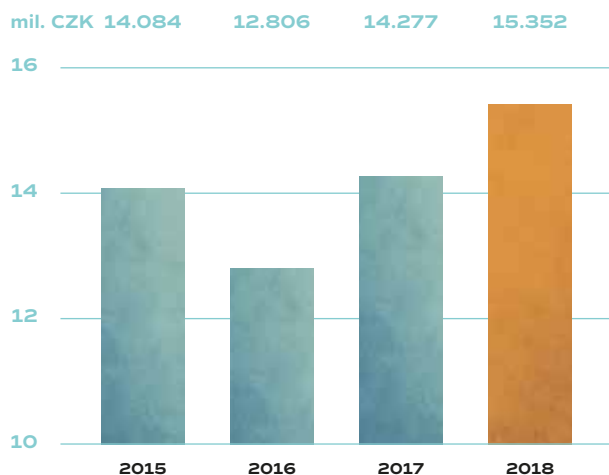
VIA'S INCOME COMPOSITION IN 2018

THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH WE LIVE

In many places in the Czech Republic, community life is still hibernating. We try to change that through the program The Community in Which We Live, which enables people in a community to come together to transform a park, square or other public space. Through a process of community planning, designing, building and celebrating, people strengthen their ties to one another and to their community and develop a sense of environmental stewardship. Our support includes grants, workshops and guidance by a community engagement expert from start to finish.

NEIGHBORS IN HORNÍ ŽDÁR CREATED THEIR OWN MICRO-WORLD

Horní Žďár is a small village in the Trutnov region. In recent years a number of families with young children have moved there from larger cities, seeking a quiet alternative to urban hustle and bustle. Yet at the same time they want to engage in community activities. A group of them decided to transform the village commons into a site for community events, campfires and everyday use. One year later the site features whimsical wooden statues, play equipment and seating. The old firefighting basin, an overgrown mess at the start of the project, has been completely cleaned out and will become a multi-purpose playing court and stage in the future. Old non-native trees have been replaced by new plantings, which let dappled sunlight into the site. The group's next move will be to build a community center.

LIVING COMMUNITIES



Small community projects bring people together. Our Living Communities program supports organizations and engaged citizens who want to improve life in their neighborhoods, create something together for the community and strengthen their own ties through the shared experience. We provide them with grants, workshops, consultations and the opportunity to meet with other people pursuing similar goals in other parts of the country. We believe it makes sense for residents to take an interest in their surroundings and help their communities become more self-sufficient. Our vision is a country full of living communities.

CHURCH IN VRBICE REJUVENATED INTO A COMMUNITY GATHERING PLACE

The small village of Vrbice lies on the western periphery of the Central Bohemian region, in the former Sudetenland, which was depopulated after World War II. The members of a local civic association are gradually revitalizing Vrbice. They rented the deconsecrated Church of the Ascension of the Holy Cross and are gradually transforming it into a place to meet, share potluck meals and talk about village news. They are sensitively restoring the church in the process. Residents organize community events themselves, meaning that everyone gives what they can. One person brings sandwiches, someone else bakes a Bundt cake, another takes care of beverages.

FAST GRANTS



Fast Grants help people who have resolved to address a pressing issue in their community. Projects focus on problems such as inefficiency in local government, wasting of public resources, environmentally harmful construction projects, vegetation loss or air and noise pollution. Along with funding, Fast Grants includes a team of two consultants that helps supported organizations develop information campaigns and involve the public in their efforts.

DESIGN WORKSHOP SHOWS THAT NO DEMOLITION IS NEEDED IN BEDŘIŠKA

Built in the early 20th century as workers' housing, the village of Bedřiška has since become part of the city of Ostrava's industrial heritage. The original dwellings are known as 'Finnish houses' and are now inhabited by approximately 36 families along with senior citizens, many of whom are retired miners. In 2018 the local government proposed to relocate the inhabitants, demolish the Finnish houses and sell the properties to investors for development of new housing. But Bedřiška residents decided to protect their home. With the help of a local NGO, local celebrities and many volunteers, they held an urban design workshop that came up with alternative development options for Bedřiška – options that helped residents stay in their village.

VIABILITYNET 3.0



Through ViabilityNet 3.0, we support, train and connect engaged citizens from Central and Eastern Europe. ViabilityNet participants are distinctive community leaders striving to make changes in their own communities – by developing e.g. a community market, center or library. We also initiated a network of partner organizations supporting community development in the CEE region. Their staff meet twice a year to exchange experiences and discuss ways of addressing societal polarization.

THE RAČA NEIGHBORHOOD IS EXCITING!

The Rača housing estate in Bratislava, which is similar to hundreds of others in Central and Eastern Europe, saw its first signs of revitalization 14 years ago. It was, in part, thanks to Lenka Antalová Plavuchová. Lenka is the mother of three children, a competitive swimmer and a community garden tomato grower. She first became engaged in her community through the Ráčik Family Center. There is an old school cafeteria building across the street from the center that had been slowly falling apart over the years. Lenka and her team persuaded the town hall to rent them the space for 15 years. They are going to turn it into a community center for Rača, where people of all ages will be able to spend time together.

YOUNG PHILANTHROPISTS

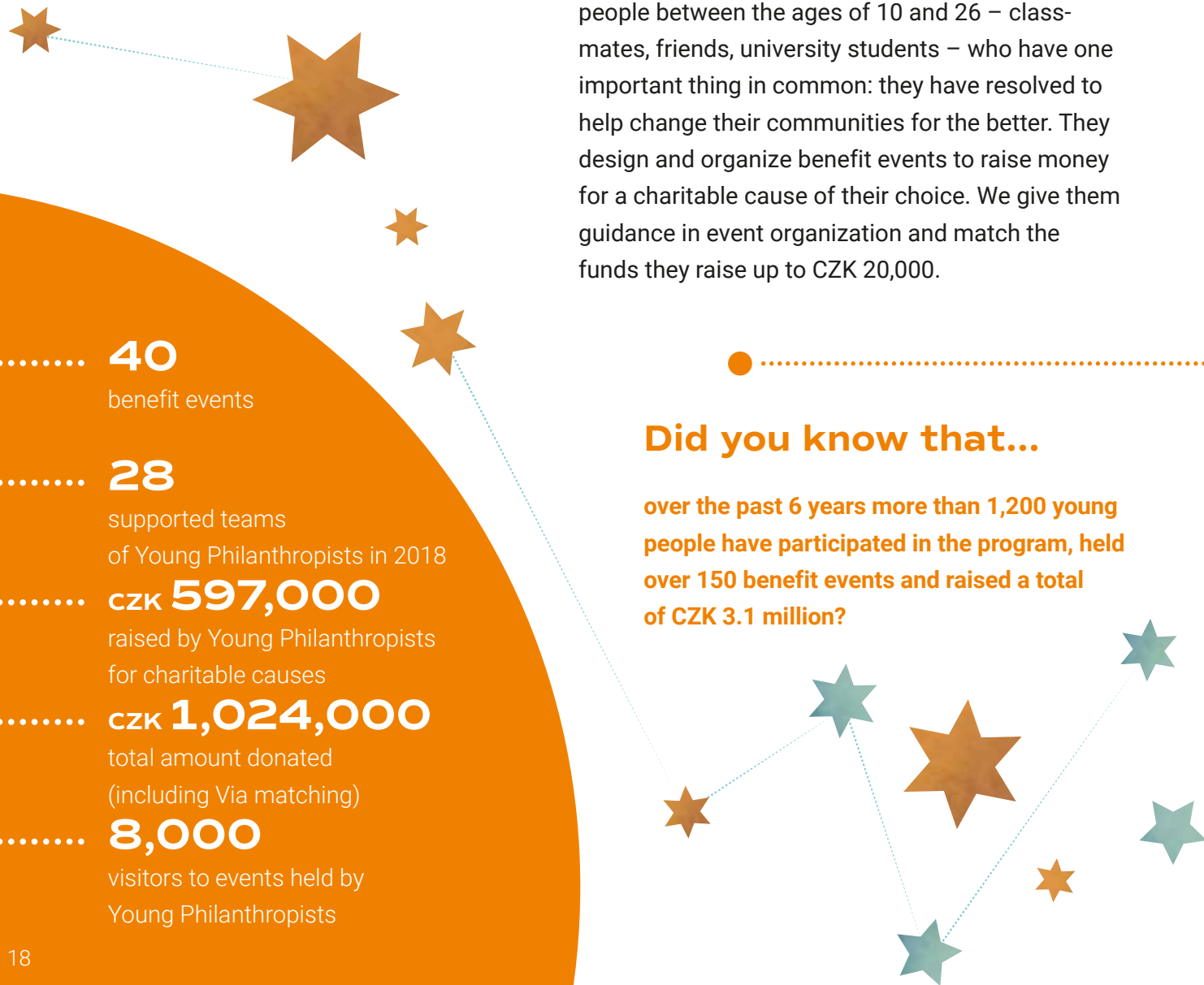

YOUNG TEAM MOTIVATED THEIR ENTIRE TOWN TO HELP A CHARITABLE CAUSE

Several years ago this all girls' team from Ondřejov renovated a bus stop and decorated it with astronomical artwork to underscore that their town has the largest observatory in Central Europe. In 2018 they turned their attention to their disabled friend Kristýnka, who is a member of the Jaguar floorball team in Prague and needed a sports wheelchair. They motivated their entire town to join in and through seven benefit events raised CZK 62,506. A total of CZK 98,648 was donated, including our matching funding.

Libor Malý: Helping Czechs in debt

PATRON CATEGORY

LIBOR MALÝ

After Libor Malý sold his successful business, which operated the job search websites Jobs.cz and Práce.cz, he began supporting the People in Need Foundation and other NGOs. In 2010 he supported the SOS Tibet fundraising drive and later funded help for victims of the Myanmar conflict. After meeting a girl who had racked up debts to pay for cancer treatment that put her on the brink of property seizure, he began fighting against the debt industry. Since 2014, his funding has enabled People in Need to contest a number of unethical laws and save Czech households over CZK 10 billion per year.

Naturfyt-BIO: Long-term efforts to improve the quality of life in Jeseník

Jeseník native and owner of Naturfyt – BIO Rodan Hojgr supports the local community and young motivated people who are revitalizing the community and developing new activities there. His support is diverse. He has helped the Arnika civic association protect and renew trees and allees, supported community events through the civic association Sudetikus and supported a local forest preschool and forest camps for children. He has also donated to the Tančírna community cultural center.

Marcela Mejstříková battled breast cancer years ago. She conquered the disease and in 1999 embarked on a new phase of life, co-founding Mamma HELP, an NGO which helps women with breast cancer. She worked at Mamma HELP as a therapist and helped establish centers in various Czech cities. In 2014, she decided to bequeath her entire estate to Mamma HELP to continue helping others even after her own passing.

PERSONAL ENGAGEMENT AWARD

LUDMILA BÖHMOVÁ

In 2006 Ludmila, her husband Karol and four friends founded the NGO SIRIRI in the Central African Republic (CAR), one of the poorest countries in the world. SIRIRI helps specific people and towns through interventions in education, health and agriculture. Ludmila believes that the only path towards future economic independence and emancipation is to develop greater self-sufficiency among local residents, with a particular focus on young people. Giving back can be passed on from generation to generation: Ludmila and Karol raised six children, all of whom have also volunteered in Africa.

PETRA SOUKUPOVÁ

The Police Symphony Orchestra is a phenomenon. Just like award-winner Petra Soukupová's astounding energy and enthusiasm. Petra and her Police Symphony Orchestra of young musicians are revitalizing the Broumov region. At age 15, Petra and her brother Jakub founded the orchestra and since then they have changed the musical landscape of their region and also raised money for the Broumov Hospital Endowment Fund. In 2019 the Police Symphony Orchestra will embark on an unusual benefit busking tour, which will also involve Via Foundation.

DISRUPTIVE PHILANTHROPIST

Alexandre Mars is a successful tech entrepreneur who loves disruption, a magic word in recent years. He tries to disrupt the traditional “laws” of philanthropy by introducing innovative giving models, such as his “Sharing Pledge” where entrepreneurs pledge a portion of their proceeds if they sell their companies.

In the Anglo-Saxon world, when a child’s tooth falls out, s/he puts it under his or her pillow for the tooth fairy. During the night the tooth disappears and in its place the child finds money. The going tooth fairy rate used to be about \$1 but with inflation it’s climbed to

about \$5. When Alexandre Mars’ daughter found money from the tooth fairy under her pillow, she said she’d give it to charity. Mars felt gratified that he had passed on his love of giving to his offspring. He told the Financial Times: “I certainly wasn’t thinking about social good when I was six.” Three years ago Mars was selected as one of New York’s top 20 philanthropists under 40.

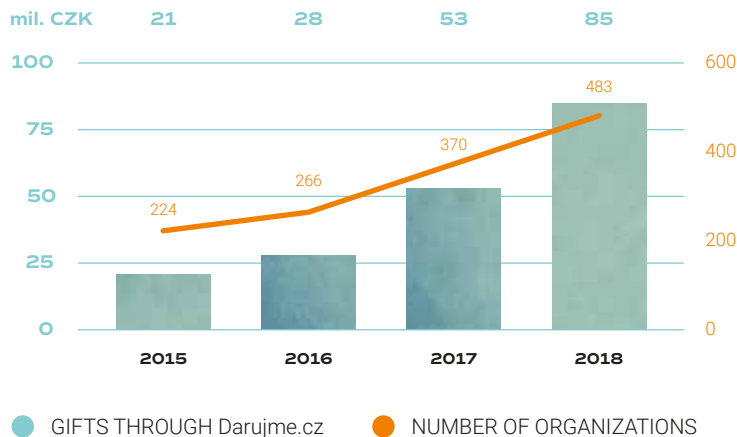

PEER-TO-PEER FUNDRAISING DRIVES

How do peer-to-peer fundraising drives on Darujme.cz work? Two examples illustrate.

David V. and David B. are friends who share a passion for cycling. They rode across the Italian Alps in a cycling race and with gifts pledged by donors, they raised over CZK 100,000 for our Young Philanthropists program.

Photographer Tomáš Třeštík asked his fans to invite him for a virtual drink for his birthday. Together, they raised over CZK 500,000, which translated into many hours of personal assistance for disabled people.

LEARNING FOR COMMUNITY LEADERS



We truly value people who want to improve their communities. We try to give them the most support we can through our learning program. One of the workshops we offered in 2018 was “How to initiate a community project”. We also conducted a survey among our grant recipients to gauge their interest in learning opportunities. In 2019 we will add travel grants for workshop participants who wouldn’t be able to attend without financial support.

DONOR FUNDS



LET'S TALK

Through the project “Zlíchov is our home”, Prague 5 fifth-graders learned about municipal planning and decision-making. They held a series of workshops that resulted in designs to improve public spaces near their schools. The project was one of 25 in the 2018 T-Mobile Let's Talk program, which enabled people to address specific issues in their communities and provided funding and learning opportunities through the T-Mobile Academy. Disadvantaged citizens also took part in the community improvement efforts.

T-MOBILE FUND

HELPING THROUGH STORIES

Ruda was born with Down's syndrome. Since his mother died, he has been making a new home for himself at the Kamarád LORM sheltered housing facility. Thanks to T-Mobile's traditional Helping through Stories employee fundraising drive, Ruda was able to make his home cozier. The drive raised a total of CZK 509,000 in 2018, which T-Mobile matched with another CZK 500,000. In January 2019, Via Foundation awarded grants to 20 people in crisis in a total amount of CZK 1,009,900. The grant recipients were nominated by T-Mobile employees.

VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

Although Zdeněk Bumbálek works full-time at T-Mobile, he has found time to build two social enterprises that help disabled people. Blind people transcribe conversations for deaf people, who use the transcriptions to call and deal with government authorities. T-Mobile recognized Zdeněk and other employees who volunteer for charitable causes in autumn 2018 with its Volunteer of the Year award. T-Mobile gave the award-winners CZK 50,000 for the non-profit organizations in which they serve as volunteers.

In 2018 T-Mobile supported a total of 53 projects through Via Foundation in a total amount of CZK 3,009,483.

EUROWAG FUND

Donate EUR 300 to any organization or needy person in your community. That's what W.A.G. payment solutions proposed to its employees to support them in charitable giving. In 2018 the company set up a new fund at Via Foundation, the Eurowag Fund. Via developed a special application to distribute grants from the fund. In 2018, 478 Eurowag employees took part by selecting some 226 projects for support in 14 countries around the world. The total amount distributed was CZK 3,704,400.

RACHŮNEK FUND

Marek Herman, founder of the Rachůnek Fund and author of the book "Find Your Own Martian", is dedicated to the education and development of parents of children under the age of six. The Rachůnek Fund ("rachunek" means account in Polish), which he founded at Via Foundation, has the same focus. It is a permanent fund, which means that only the fund yields are used. In 2018 a grant of CZK 50,000 was awarded from the fund to the Polárka association of foster parents, which enables children to grow up in families.

SÝKORA FAMILY FUND

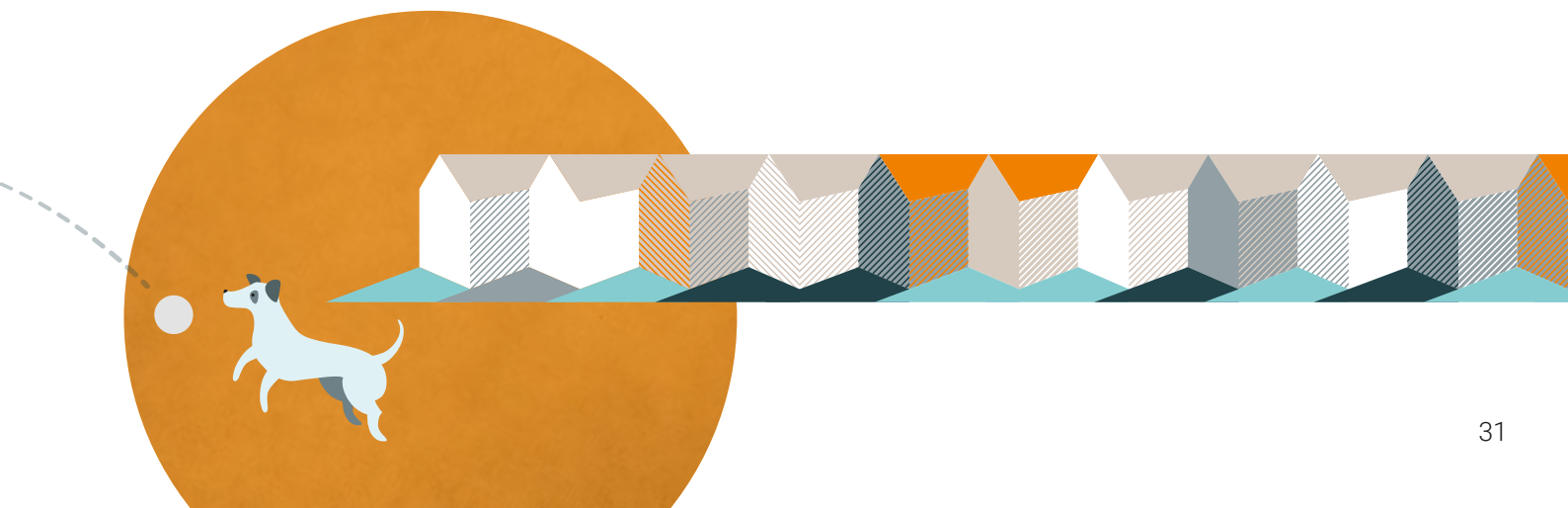
The Sýkora Family Fund is a great example of family philanthropy. Mr. Sýkora and Mrs. Sýkorová, who established the fund, include their children in selecting charitable projects to support through the fund each year. The Sýkora Family Fund is a permanent fund, which means that only the fund yields are used to support charitable projects. In 2018 the Sýkora Family Fund awarded a total of CZK 40,000 in two grants to the following projects: a most engaged high school student competition and the Czech Red Cross Rescue Marathon Kids edition.

THREE SISTERS ARE HELPING FUND

The musical band Three Sisters established its own donor fund at Via Foundation at the end of 2011. Since then the fund has been used to support people who must rely on others' help or who suddenly find themselves in crisis due to an accident, illness or other personal tragedy. In 2018 a total of CZK 65,655 was awarded from the fund to e.g. purchase an electrical wheelchair and cover the costs of a personal assistant for a disabled child.

PARTNER PROJECTS



NO FEAR OF LOCAL POLITICS

In 2018 we piloted a new Via program called “No Fear of Local Politics”, which seeks to encourage engaged citizens to run for local office and to promote a citizen-friendly local government. In the pilot phase we assessed the needs of local elected officials and engaged citizens who are considering running for local office. We held two focus groups, conducted a survey with 300 respondents and held community meetings in the towns of Liberec, Jeseník and Žatec, which attracted a total of 100 people. On the basis of this research, we developed the new program, which will offer workshops and mentoring to familiarize potential local representatives with municipal issues and the principles of accountability and responsibility in public office. Starting in 2019 we will also help five towns hold community discussion forums to spark residents’ interest in local issues.

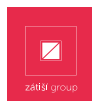

COMPOSITION OF VIA FOUNDATION EXPENSES IN 2018

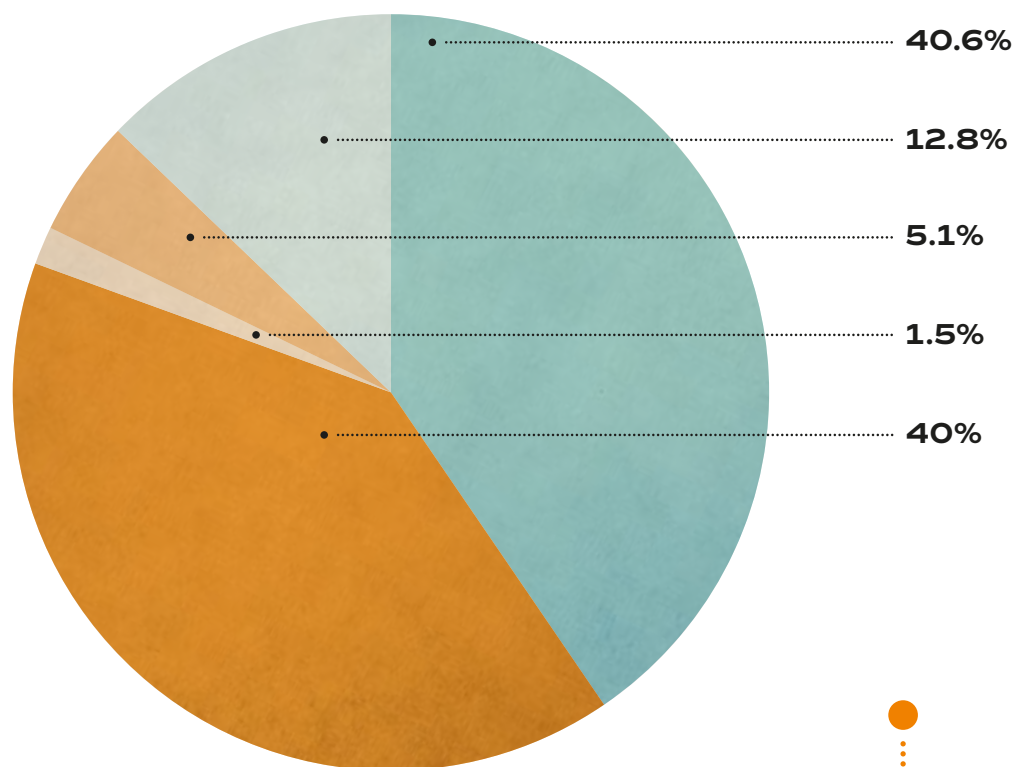

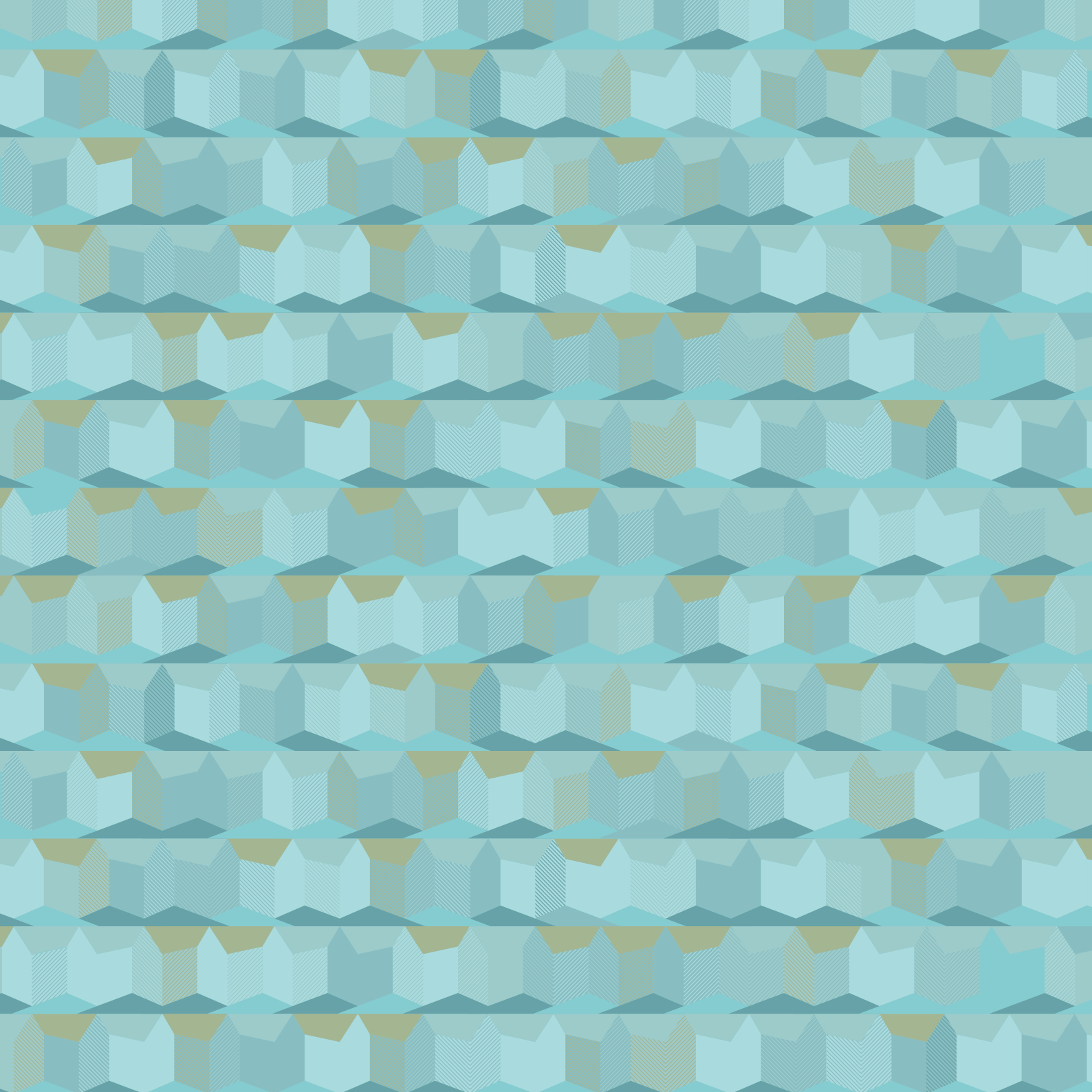
